Good morning Phantoms! Today is Monday, May 18, and we are following a special Senior Finals Schedule.

What's New?

- This week, we will all be following a special schedule to allow the seniors to take their Final Exams in the morning, followed by Graduation Practice in the afternoon. Today, all students will attend their Homeroom, Period 1, Period 2 and Period 3 with a dismissal time of 1:15pm. Following our dismissal time, all teachers will be available for all Freshmen, Sophomores and Juniors until 2:30 pm for final exam tutoring. Seniors are required to attend Graduation practice in the gymnasium, starting at 1:25 pm.

Important note: All seniors are required to complete your Final Exams and attend ALL Graduation Practices each day in order for you to attend Graduation on Friday night.

- Due to AP Testing, the Library and Cafeteria will be closed for the remainder of the week. The library is scheduled to reopen on Tuesday, May 19. We apologize for any inconvenience and appreciate your understanding.

General School Information
