Have you ever seen a platypus in real life before? Or even in a picture? They are kind of weird looking, aren't they! Some people say it shows that God has a sense of humor! They are duck, beaver, and otter! If you think that's crazy, take a look at these amazing facts on platypuses! (Scientific name: Ornithohynchus Anatinus)

Baby platypuses are called puggles. Puggles are born from an egg, but they drink their mother's milk! Platypus eggs weigh 0.01 to 0.03 pounds. They are 11 to 17 mm in size and 0.43 to 0.67 inches in diameter. They also have a whitish color.

Adult platypuses eat freshwater shrimp, insect larvae, crayfish, worms, and snails. Platypuses live in eastern Australia, Queensland, New South Wales, Victoria, and Tasmania. But you can find a captive platypus here in the United States at the San Diego Zoo in California. Now you know about Platypuses, and maybe now you love them as much as I do!

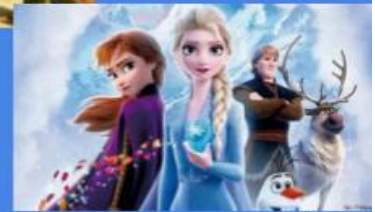
1. Platypuses are 1 of 2 mammals that lay eggs. (echidna)

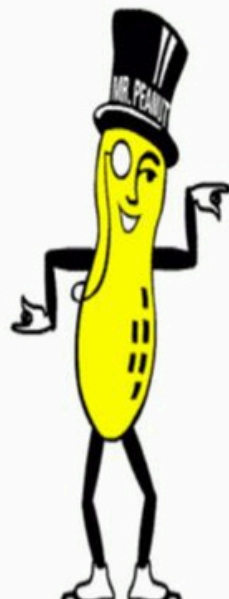
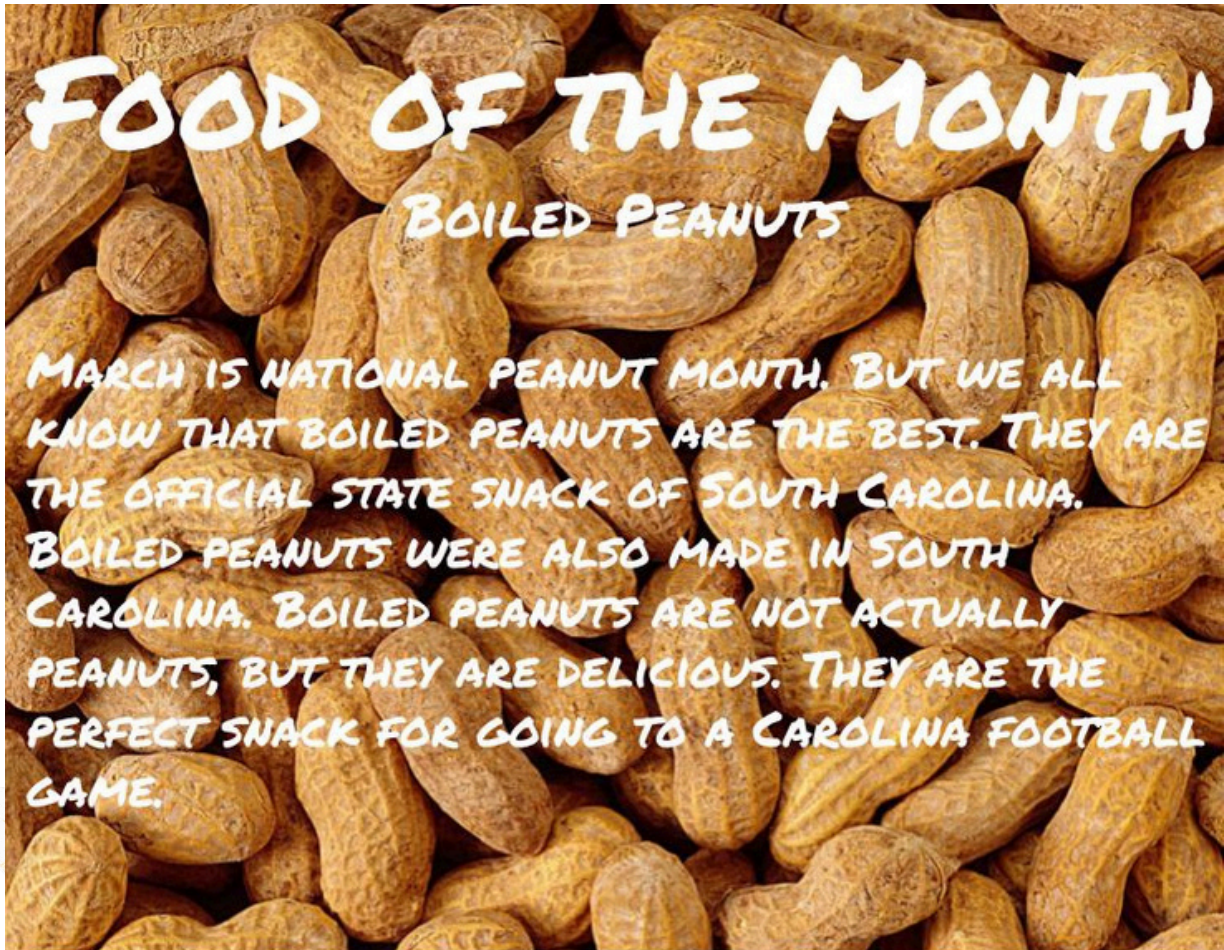

3. CUT A BIG CIRCLE OUT OF THE PLATE AND KEEP THE RING. PAINT THE PAPER PLATE GREEN.



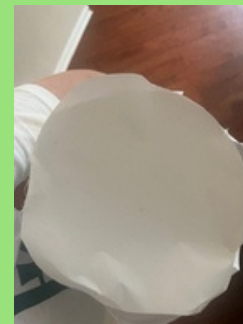
4. COLOR THE LONG PIECE OF PAPER LIKE A HAT.
