Hello Trojan Families,

This is Principal Bender with your Trojan updates for the week of May 18-22.

Finals week is just around the corner, help your student study smarter, not harder!

To help your student finish the semester strong, here are some helpful hints:

- **Block, Don't Cram:** Map out a study schedule now. Divide review time into 25-minute focused blocks (the Pomodoro technique) rather than marathon cram sessions the night before.
- **Test Yourself, Don't Just Read:** Ditch the passive highlighting. Students should use active recall methods like flashcards, practice tests, or explaining concepts out loud to test what you *actually* know. (summarize)
- **Get Organized & Ask for Help:** Students should gather worksheets, organize notebooks and study guides today. For additional support, students should attend teacher office hours during lunch or before/after school. They want to help our students succeed!
- **Protect Your Brain:** Sleep is your ultimate secret weapon. Students should try to aim for 8 hours of sleep, stay hydrated, and eat a solid breakfast on exam morning.

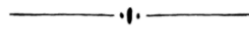

Student Eligibility

(Please refer to the LHS Student Handbook for more details.)

Academic Criteria: The student must be maintaining minimum progress toward meeting the high school graduation requirements as prescribed by the governing board. Student must maintain at least a 2.00 GPA and have no F's.

Attendance Criteria: A student may not have more 7 unexcused single-period absences and no more than 10 unexcused tardies.

Other Criteria: Any student suspended for more than 3 days for a single incident will become immediately ineligible for extracurricular activities and athletics for 30 calendar days from the day the student returns to school

Community Service Opportunity

Have you considered earning your Community Service Award? Complete 100 hours of community service in one year and earn a special award lanyard to wear at graduation. Two for one hours are given in the garden every Wednesday during 7th period. Spend 7th period in the garden with the Harvest club and get signed for two hours. See you Wednesday.

Clearing Absences

REMINDER: YOU HAVE ONLY 2 SCHOOL DAYS (48 HRS) TO CLEAR ABSENCES

Attendance Phone Number (209) 953-8926

Parents or legal guardians are asked to call the Attendance Office at 953-8926 to notify if your student is absent, arriving late, or needs to leave campus during the school day for an appointment. You can also send a note with the student and have them drop it off to the Attendance Office in the morning.

For full day absences, voicemail is available 24 hrs a day. When leaving a voicemail, please clearly say and/or spell your student's name. Also, leave the date of the absence, the reason and your name and relationship to the student.






Parents/guardians can also excuse absences via ParentSquare by simply responding to the email/notification that will be sent out the evening of the absence or tardy.

The attendance office needs parent/guardian permission BEFORE a student may leave campus, either by a signed note with the student or a phone call ahead of time.
