Yearbook Distribution Week

The wait is over, Yearbook Distribution Week is almost here! Distribution will take place after school from 4:00 to 5:00 PM in Room J1 from **May 19th through May 22nd**.

Here are the details for the distribution schedule:

- > Tuesday, May 19th will be distribution for seniors and staff ONLY.
- > Wednesday, May 20th and Thursday, May 21st will be distribution for the rest of the student body.
- > Friday, May 22nd will be the final day of distribution for all students. Room J1 will be open during both lunches and after school for pick up.

If you have not purchased a yearbook yet, there will be a LIMITED number of extra books available for purchase during distribution week for \$120. Once our limited stock sells out, there will be NO more yearbooks available, so please don't wait! We have sold out all our yearbooks in the past.

PLEASE NOTE: all yearbook purchases must be made through the bookkeeper with cash or card only during distribution week.

FEES & FINES: Got fines? **IMPORTANT NOTICE: 2026–2027 Student Fee Enforcement Policy**

PER TUSD HANDBOOK:

Any student who owes fees and does not clear their fees prior to the beginning of the year may not be permitted to participate in, or attend any extra or co-curricular activities, and purchase a yearbook until such fees are paid. Furthermore, students may not be allowed to participate in sports, cheer squad, dance team, dance/prom activities, etc., until all fines are cleared or they have made arrangements with the school site administration.

DRESS CODE

• Violent language or images.

Specific areas of the body must always be covered for all students. Clothes must be worn in a way such that genitals, buttocks, chest, torso, and abdomen are covered with opaque fabric. Students are expected to wear clothing that remains appropriate at all times, including while walking, sitting, or moving without the need for constant adjustments.

Any item that obscures the face or ears (except as a religious observance and/or health guideline such as face masks).

POLICY AND PROCEDURES:

- **ABSENCE PROCEDURES:** Please have your parents/guardian call or e-mail the school on the date of your absence. If unable to do so, students should bring a note to school to clear the absence when they first return to school. It is the student and parent/guardian's responsibility to verify an absence, **and they must do so within 48 hours upon returning to school**. An auto dialer will notify parents/guardian when a student is absent from school for a portion of the day. **A student will receive four hours of Saturday School for being truant for two or more periods.**
- **SATURDAY SCHOOL HOURS:** – are held in the **CAFETERIA** from 8am – 12pm. **BE ON TIME... NO LATE ARRIVALS!**
 - **MUST BRING ENOUGH WORK or will be asked to leave.**
 - **No Cell phone use only school laptop is allowed (PLEASE MAKE SURE LAPTOPS ARE FULLY CHARGED).**

District policy states a student owing more than 15 hours of Saturday School will be placed on **Activity/Social Probation** until Saturday School hours are reduced to 15 hours or below.

(Extra/co-curricular activities such as, but not limited to, **sports teams, DANCES, i.e., PROM, student government, class office, dance team, cheer squad, homecoming or other rally activities, newspaper or yearbook staff, and drama.**)

- **PARKING PERMITS:**
Parking Permits are required for any student that drives to school. Pick up a form in the office to get a Parking Pass. Must PARK car in the designated "Student Parking" area. Please make sure you are parking in the right section of our parking lot. Security will check that all cars have a permit and are parked in the student parking lot.
- **DRESS CODE POLICY: Will be enforced.**
BASIC PRINCIPLE: Certain body parts must always be covered for ALL STUDENTS. Clothes must be worn in a way such that genitals, buttocks, chest, and torso are covered with opaque fabric. All items listed in the "must wear" and "may wear" categories in the handbook must meet this basic principle.
- **LUNCH/BLUE LINE:**
The Blue line will be enforced during lunch periods. Students must have a pass to go to a teacher's classroom prior to going to that teacher's room. Students should not eat in the classroom.
- **DELIVERY OF ITEMS TO SCHOOL: Per TUSD Handbook, page 33**
Personal items related to school business (such as lunch (from home) or student work) may be accepted at the main office and students will be notified during passing periods. Students will not be called out of class to receive these items. To ensure the safety of students and staff and minimize interruption of our instructional programs, food deliveries from a delivery service will be denied by the office and security personnel. (i.e., DoorDash, Uber Eats, GrubHub, PostMates, etc.)

Per TUSD Handbook –
