Most camps will run for one week.

- **For half-day camps**, the morning session runs from 9:00 AM to 12:00 PM, and the afternoon session runs from 12:30 PM to 3:30 PM.
- **Full-day camps** run from 9:00 AM to 3:30 PM, with a built-in lunch block that may or may not align with the standard Lunch Bunch schedule.
- Certain camps, as indicated in this catalog, will follow nontraditional schedules.
- There will be a **supervised 30-minute Lunch Bunch** each day for campers attending both morning and afternoon camps. Supervision is free of charge.
- If your child is registered for the morning session and you need them to stay for Lunch Bunch until 12:30 PM, a fee of \$25.00 will apply.
- **Before Care** is available from **7:45 AM to 8:45 AM each day** for families needing early drop-off. The fee for this service is \$10.00 per day.
- **After Care** is available from **3:30 PM to 5:00 PM each day** for families needing late pick-up. The fee for this service is \$15.00 per day.
- For **Late Pick-Up** after 5:00 PM, a fee of \$30.00 will be added to the family's account.

**XPLORE: Summer at TVS** will observe the following holidays. No camps or programs will run on these dates:

- May 25, 2026 (Memorial Day)
- June 19, 2026 (Juneteenth)
- June 29 - July 3, 2026 (Independence Day: full-week holiday for campers and staff)

- **Weeks 1–4 (May 26–June 26)** Registration closes on May 1, 2026 at 8:00 AM. After this date, no refunds will be issued. Families who have registered are secured in the camp. Ongoing weekly registration for future weeks will remain open until Wednesday of the preceding week, allowing families to join the following week's camp.
- **Weeks 5–8 (July 6–July 31)** Registration closes on June 1, 2026 at 8:00 AM. After this date, no refunds will be issued. Families who have registered are secured in the camp. Ongoing weekly registration for future weeks will remain open until Wednesday of the preceding week, allowing families to join the following week's camp.

## Registration and Billing

- Program registration, billing, and family communications will be managed through the Auxiliary Programs registration platform.
- All families **must** create a profile in the system and provide current, valid credit card information for automatic processing of new charges and refunds.

## Policies and Waivers

- Families **must agree** to the **2026 XPLORE waivers and releases** during the registration process. A copy of these waivers is available [here](#).
- One key waiver is the **XPLORE: Summer at TVS Cancellation + Transfer Policy**, which can be found [here](#).
- Some programs will incorporate technology to enhance the camper experience. All instructors, counselors, interns, and campers must adhere to the **XPLORE Technology Responsible Use Policy**, available [here](#).

## Language and Communication

- English is the primary language of instruction, including in foreign language and culture-based programs.
- For safety reasons, all participants must be able to **understand verbal instructions from staff**. Some instructors may incorporate age-appropriate, literacy-based activities.

## Identification and Safety

- It is essential that **all participants know their first and last name**.
- Campers will receive identification each day. Names will be used frequently for purposes such as roster reconciliation during carpool, group identification (e.g., Lunch Bunch, Before and Aftercare), and managing medical needs.

## Age Requirements

- Campers must be at least 4 years old by the start of the summer season (May 26, 2026).
- Incoming TVS PreKindergarten students who are turning 4 by June 30, 2026, **may attend age-appropriate camps in June if admitted to TVS PreKindergarten for the 2026-2027 school year**.
- Our camps are designed for participants from rising PreKindergarten through rising Grade 12. High school alumni are not eligible to attend.

## Restroom Independence

- Independence includes the ability to perform basic functions, flush the toilet, and wash hands properly.
- If a camper is not able to use the restroom independently, they will be unregistered from any remaining camps for the summer.
