

Dear FISD Community,

I'm excited to share an update on the May 2026 bond election. First, I'd like to thank you again for taking the time to vote and for your continued commitment to Friendswood ISD!

With voter approval on three propositions, I'd like to share what this next phase will look like. While you may not see immediate activity on our campuses, a great deal of work will be happening behind the scenes this summer and fall to ensure the bond projects are carefully planned and responsibly executed.

In the coming months, our primary focus will be on infrastructure improvements across our campuses and planning for the construction of the expanded Career & Agricultural Sciences Center. We will begin the formal process of selling bonds, developing project designs, securing necessary permits and approvals, and soliciting bids to identify qualified contractors. A list of FAQs follows this letter and provides more detail about the steps we'll take in the coming months.

This deliberate approach is essential to ensuring projects are designed thoughtfully, budgets are finalized responsibly, and construction timelines are aligned with student and campus needs. While this early work may not be immediately visible to the public, it lays the foundation for successful, efficient construction once projects move forward.

With the defeat of Proposition B, the proposal to replace Westwood Elementary with a new school, we will study options for the aging campus and develop a plan to move forward – just as we did after the failed election in November 2025. As options are considered and decisions made about this campus, we will keep you informed.

I'm grateful for the community's support of Propositions A, C, and D, and knowing that these bond-funded projects will allow us to address safety updates, infrastructure needs, and student program expansion.

We remain committed to being responsible stewards of your tax dollars and to delivering on the promises outlined in the bond proposal. We will be transitioning the Bond 2026 website into a forum where you can see the progress of various projects on campuses, as well as the Career and Agricultural Science Center. Thank you again for your trust, your engagement, and your continued support of Friendswood ISD.

We look forward to sharing updates as this important work progresses.
