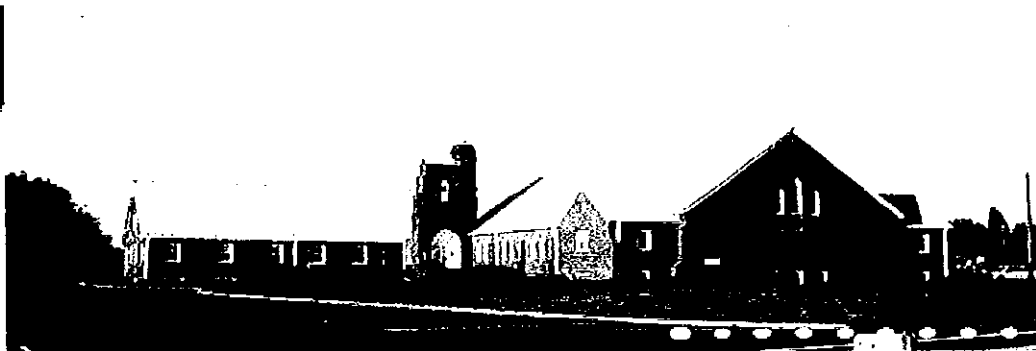

More summer smiles with North Carolina SUN Bucks

SUN Bucks is a US Department of Agriculture (USDA) program that provides grocery-buying benefits to qualifying families with school-aged children during the summer months when schools are out. Families receive a **one-time payment of \$120 in food assistance benefits per eligible child.**

Benefits will be issued on debit-like EBT cards that can be used to buy nutritious food at grocery stores, farmers markets, and some online retailers. Benefit amounts may vary year to year.



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► **Who is eligible for SUN Bucks?** Many children will be automatically enrolled for SUN Bucks based on their participation in other qualifying benefit programs. Other children **will need to apply**. Visit the NCDHHS SUN Bucks website, ncdhhs.gov/sunbucks to learn about eligibility and to apply.

► **Stay updated on SUN Bucks!** Visit ncdhhs.gov/sunbucks for more information and answers to frequently asked questions. Search "NCDHHS" on [Instagram](#), [Facebook](#), and [X](#) and follow the account to stay in the loop for important program updates and announcements.

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Other ways to fuel youth during the summer: In addition to receiving SUN Bucks, families also are encouraged to have their children, ages 18 and younger, participate in other federal Summer Nutrition Programs available at no cost to them.
