HotelPlanner Tour

In March, Logan Perkins won the Qualifying tournament for the HotelPlanner Tour. The HotelPlanner Tour (formerly the European Challenge Tour) is the second-tier men's professional golf tour in Europe, operated by the PGA European Tour to prepare players for the DP World Tour. It features 29+ international events—often called the "Road to Mallorca"—where top finishers earn DP World Tour cards.

Logan's win qualifies him for eight guaranteed starts on the tour, giving him a "card" or status on the tour. The HotelPlanner Tour is equivalent to the Korn Ferry Tour which is the primary developmental tour for the U.S.-based PGA Tour, serving as the main pathway for professional golfers to earn membership on the top-tier PGA Tour.



## CONGRATULATIONS LOGAN!



Logan will need to finish top ten on the HotelPlanner Tour points list for the season to advance to the DP World Tour. The first event was May 14 in Gerona, Spain at Fontanals Golf Club.

Logan also has status or a "card" on PGA Tour Americas, but is choosing to play on the HotelPlanner Tour as it is closer to the larger tour in Europe than the PGA Tour Americas is in the United States and it gives him the best chance to play at the highest level. Some of the places he will play include: Switzerland, Austria, France, Scotland, Sweden and many other places in Europe.



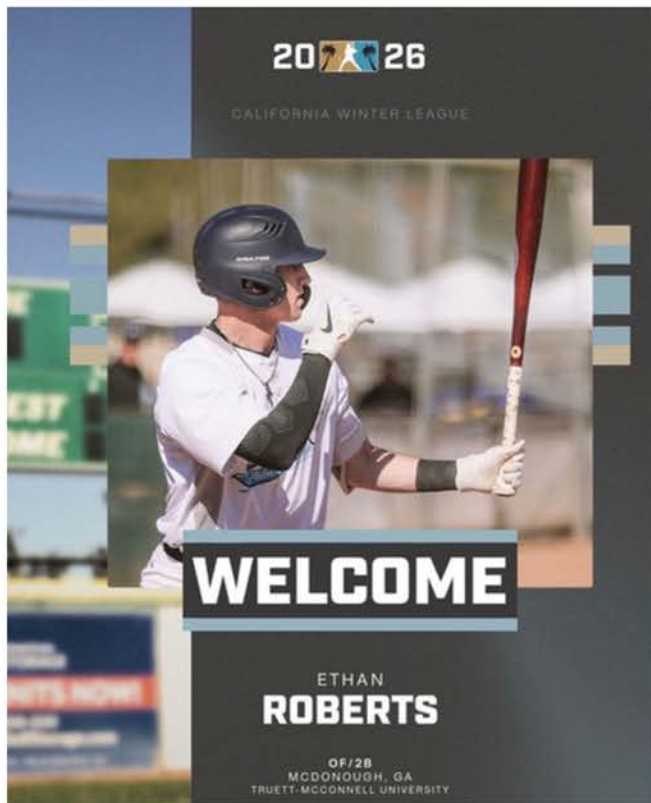

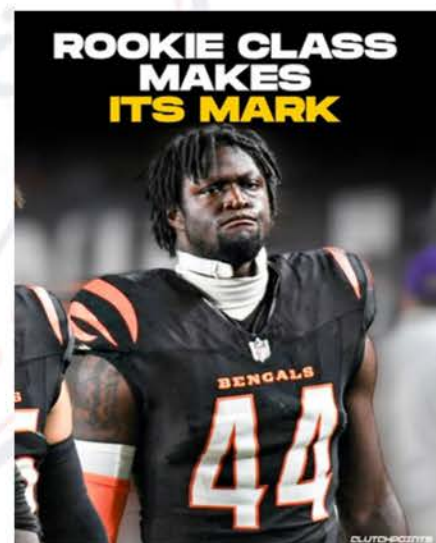
# Demetrius Knight Jr.

The Cincinnati Bengals leaned on their rookie class more than most teams in the league during the 2025 season, ranking seventh in the NFL.

Cincinnati Bengals linebacker Demetrius Knight Jr. was recognized as a 2025 NFL All-Rookie Honorable Mention by The Athletic after showing significant growth and strong performances late in his rookie season. The second-round pick out of South Carolina was noted for his improvement, finishing the year strong after playing 798 snaps.



Key 2025 Rookie Season Highlights:

- Late-Season Surge: Knight posted his two highest-graded games in Weeks 17 and 18, signaling substantial development.
- Impact Playmaking: He recorded a two-sack game against the Ravens in Week 15, at that time tying for the most sacks by a rookie linebacker.
- SIS Recognition: He was also named to the 2025 SIS NFL All-Rookie 2nd Team as a linebacker. Knight was praised for his ability to play inside run effectively and his capacity to cover space.

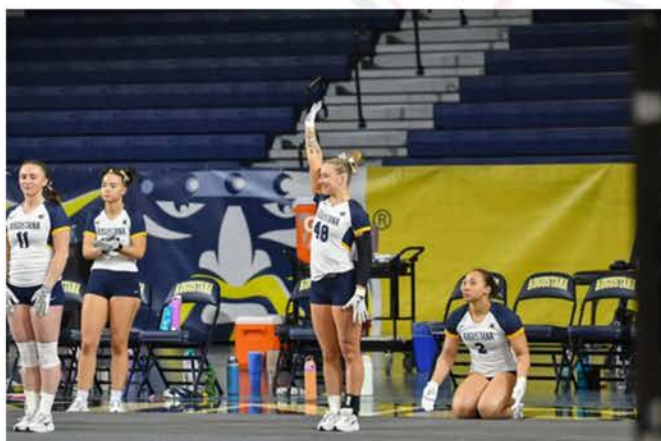


## A Job Well Done

## Carrying Forward a Legacy of Service

When I look back on my time at SRCS, I realize just how much those years shaped the person I am today. I'm currently studying Biology at Georgia State University, but the lessons I learned at SRCS continue to guide me every day—especially the importance of serving others with love and compassion.

During my time at SRCS, I discovered a passion for helping people in need. I organized a blanket drive for individuals experiencing homelessness, and many of my quarterly projects focused on finding ways to serve others in meaningful ways. Through those experiences, I learned that even the smallest acts of kindness can make a lasting impact.

While I was in high school, I met my boyfriend, whose family has deep roots in Glen Haven and a remarkable legacy of community service. His grandparents, Gale and Tom Harris, founded Road Runners, an outreach ministry dedicated to feeding and supporting people in need through food drives and other service efforts. Gale, especially, spent her life showing Christ's love through selfless acts of kindness and generosity.

A few years ago, Gale became ill and passed away. In her memory, our family organized a small blanket drive on Thanksgiving. What began as a simple way to honor her quickly grew into something much greater. My boyfriend's sister, Mariah, and I felt called to continue the work Gale cared so deeply about and carry on her spirit of service. From that desire, Touch of Gale was born.



Each spring, Touch of Gale hosts a bag drive where every \$5 donation helps create either a toiletry bag or a food bag for someone in need. We personally organize and assemble every bag ourselves. When we launched our first drive, the response from the community was overwhelming.

Thanks to the incredible generosity of others, we were able to create and distribute more than 100 bags.

During the winter months, we collect blankets, coats, gloves, sleeping bags, tents, and other cold-weather essentials to help individuals stay warm. Every drive reminds us how compassionate and giving our community truly is.

I truly believe SRCS planted the seed for this passion in my heart. Through mission projects, service days, and the encouragement of teachers like Mrs. Mann, Mrs. Thompson, Mrs. Parrish, Dr. Sanders, and so many others, I learned what it means to serve others faithfully and wholeheartedly. They taught us not only how to strive for excellence, but also how important it is to be a blessing to others.

I'm deeply thankful for the foundation SRCS gave me, and I'm grateful for the opportunity to continue that mission through Touch of Gale. Our spring drive has recently wrapped up, and we're already looking forward to preparing for our winter drive after summer ends.

Thank you to everyone who has supported us, donated, prayed, and helped us continue Gale's legacy. Together, we can remind people that they are seen, cared for, and loved.

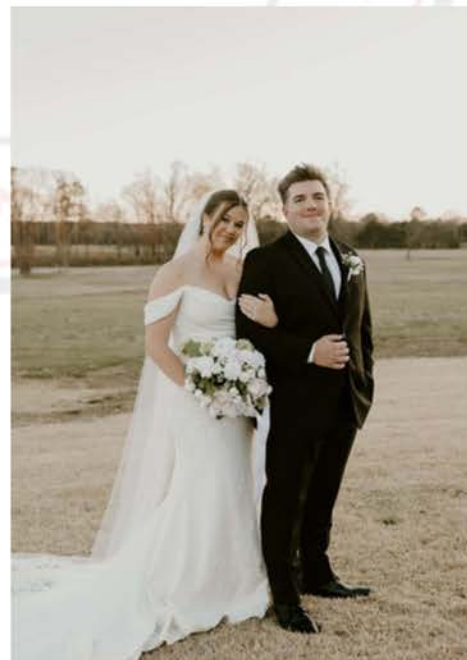

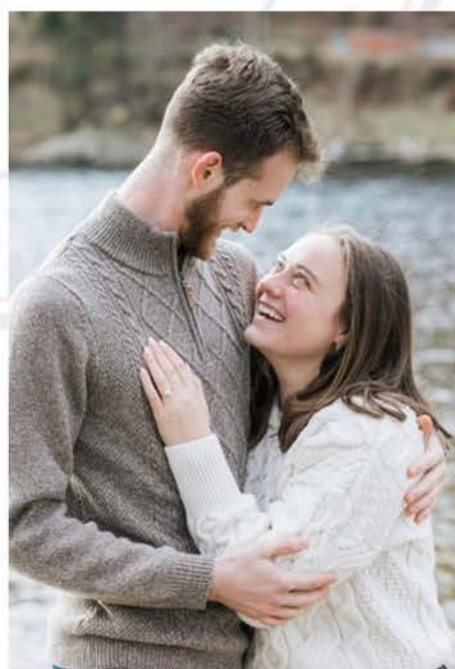

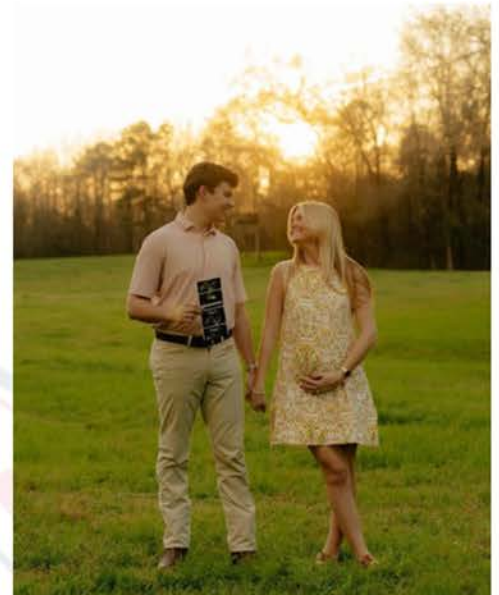
