

# Onteora Board Notes

The Onteora Central School Board of Education met last Monday evening in Boiceville. Following is a list of items discussed and/or acted upon:

The intermediate working plans on the new elementary school were approved by the Board and will be submitted to Albany for approval.

Bids will be let out for a sep-

arate contract for the rough grading of road leading to the new school. Plans and specifications will be available at Onteora. Estimated cost \$9,000 to \$10,000. Legal notices pertaining to the work posted in the Onteora Record.

Board looked over compositions written by OCS students from 1st to 6th grades in the "Name the New School Contest".

Mr. Moehle reported that some

6,000 questionnaires on Tax Relief for the Retired were mailed out recently. Over a thousand have been returned by area residents with more than 90% favoring a study to see the plan through.

Several new teachers appointed to replace teachers on leave.

A study will be made of possibly hiring well-trained high calibre teachers in line with Onteora's rapid growth in stature and number.

It was reported that \$250 was presented to the Woodstock Library.

The Onteora School Board will have dinner with the Rondout Valley School Board at their school on Feb. 23.

Discussed tuition for Woodstock and Onteora students attending Kingston High.

Mr. Moehle reported that two accounts in escrow have been established for Woodstock No. 2 school at the Woodstock Branch Bank of Orange County. One is for the General School Fund and the other a Classroom Fund.
