### Competitive Swim Skills - Summer Program

Churchville-Chili Swim Coaches

This swim skills program is designed to help swimmers build and refine the fundamental skills needed for competitive swimming in a way that is fun, supportive, and confidence-building. The clinic serves as a bridge between swim lessons and school teams for young swimmers testing the waters, and a way to stay fit and maintain endurance for seasoned swimmers. The goal is not just skill development, but to make swimming enjoyable and accessible for all kids, helping them feel successful, motivated and excited to continue swimming at the modified and JV/Varsity levels.

Anyone who can safely swim freestyle unassisted in both shallow and deep water and has some knowledge of or a willingness to learn all four competitive race strokes (butterfly, backstroke, breaststroke, and freestyle) is eligible for Swim Skills.

Swimmers should wear a one-piece bathing suit, a swim cap, and competitive goggles. Recommended goggles are the Speedo Unisex-Adult Swim Goggles Vanquisher 2.0 found on amazon.com.

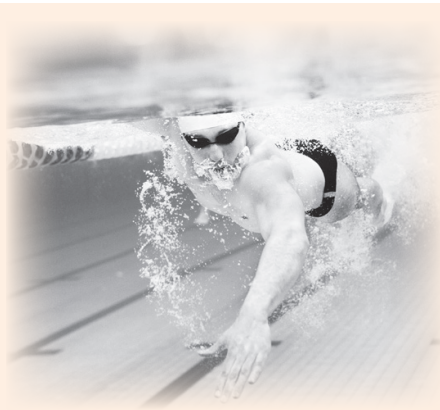

#### Details You Should Know

- You will enter the facility at Entrance 5 of the Senior High School. Upon arrival at the pool, patrons must sign in with their community fitness membership number.
- Swimmers are asked to arrive wearing their swimsuit under their clothing. Appropriate bathing attire must be worn. No cutoffs or street clothes.
- Lockers will be available to place clothing while swimming. Please bring your own lock. Any locks remaining that evening will be cut off and the contents will be removed and placed in lost and found.
- Street shoes are not permitted on the pool deck.
- All patrons must shower before entering the pool. There are showers available on the deck.
- Instructions given by the lifeguards must always be obeyed.

#### Walking

Residents are encouraged to get up and move. During the school year, the high school hallways will be open each Monday through Thursday. **There is no hall walking when school is not in session during the summer.**

Plein Air is French for "in the open air" and is the practice of painting landscapes or subjects directly from nature, outdoors, rather than inside. In this unique class held entirely outdoors at various locations around Churchville, Carole will assist participants in how to capture an outdoor scene with a micron pen, then complete the sketch with a watercolor wash that will bring the illustration to life. Whether you're a beginner or an experienced artist, this workshop is designed to help you develop your skills, experiment with different techniques, and find your creative voice.

Students will first meet in the parking lot at Churchville Elementary School at 36 West Buffalo Rd and then travel to their destination. All class supplies for your watercolor painting are included and yours to keep. Please bring a chair, hat, and water bottle to clean your brush. 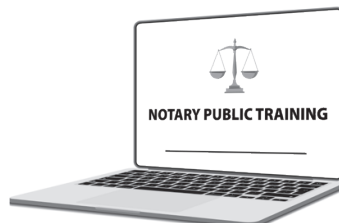
