The University Police Department (UPD) consists of the Patrol Division and the Special Services Division. The department provides police and security services twenty-four hours a day, seven days a week to all LSU Health patients, visitors, staff, faculty, and students. These services consist of information, parking assistance, escort service, and police protective and investigative services. University Police Officers are sworn and commissioned police officers with full range of police powers and are empowered to make arrests in matters concerning felonies and misdemeanors. Police officers are responsible for a full range of public safety services, including crime reports, investigations, medical and fire emergencies, traffic accidents, parking violations, enforcement of laws regulating alcoholic beverage consumption, the use of controlled substances, weapons and all other incidents requiring police assistance. Guards secure parking lots provide information and assistance to patients and visitors. Communications Officers support both the University Police and Guards by monitoring the fire and security alarm systems and directing officers to trouble areas.

In addition to shuttle bus service to the more distant parking lots, officers are available for staff, students, and faculty who desire an escort from LSU Health to any parking lot. By calling 318-675-6165 an escort can be summoned to your location to accompany you to any LSU Health parking lot. If arriving for work at night, call ahead for an officer to meet you at your assigned parking lot and escort you into the building.

The University Police Department offers motorist assistance which includes jump-starting vehicles or contacting emergency road services upon request.

Potential criminal activity, suspicious persons, and other emergencies on LSU Health property may be reported directly by anyone by calling University Police at 318-675-6165.

University Police Officers issue LSU Health parking citations. After a parking citation is issued, the driver and vehicle information is entered by UPD Communications Officers. The citation is taken to the Parking Office, where they enter it into their online system. Payments shall be made online or at the Bursar's Office, located on the first floor of the Medical School. Ticket appeals are accepted through the Parking and Badge's online system. You may contact the Parking Office at 318-675-7651.

All persons associated with LSU Health must wear their ID badge when on LSU Health property.

The University Police Department provides police and security services for LSU Health. The safety and security of our students, faculty, employees, patients, and visitors here at LSU Health are of utmost importance. The University Police Department, in conjunction with the other LSU Health departments, strives to provide a safe campus. However, a truly safe campus can only be achieved through the cooperation of all persons who use, visit and work on the campus. You can contribute to a safe environment by supporting your University Police Department in its efforts and by utilizing preventative measures to reduce the opportunity for criminal acts.
