



Q: Paying the State formula for high school tuition (Seneca Falls Rate) was a concern when our students attended Tuxedo. Why did we agree to use the State formula for Chester and Warwick?

For districts like Greenwood Lake and Tuxedo, the formula is skewed or disproportionate and does not accurately reflect the cost.

For typical Districts, the formula is an accurate representation of cost to educate.

New York State sets clear rules for how school districts charge tuition when they educate students from another district. The key principle is straightforward: **a district cannot charge more than the actual cost (State Formula) of educating a student.**
