Dear Students, Parents and Neighbors,

The Alcott construction team is excited to build your new school, and we want to tell you what's been happening on the job site!

WHAT WE'VE FINISHED:

- A construction trailer arrived — this is where the construction team works.
- Important pipes and wires were placed underground.
- Fences were set up around the job site to keep everyone safe.

- Digging holes for the building's pipes and electricity.



SAFETY TIPS:

- Trucks come 4–5 days a week between 7 AM–2:30 PM. Stay back and make sure drivers can see you.

- Listen to flaggers — they help keep everyone safe.
- Don't go inside fenced-off areas.
- Tell an adult if you see something strange near the construction site.

WHAT WE'RE WORKING ON NOW:

- Making a safe driveway for trucks.
- Removing old things from the ground to make space for new building parts.
- Planning where heating, electric and water pipes go.

WHAT'S COMING UP NEXT:

- More builders will join the project.
- Getting the ground ready for the school's foundation.



IMPORTANT INFO:

WORKING HOURS

Standard work hours are 7:00 AM to 5:00 PM, Monday–Friday.
We may need to work at night or weekends.
Working hours will be in compliance with King County ordinances.

NOISE & VIBRATION

Backup alarms must stay on for safety per Washington Industrial Safety and Health Act (WISHA).

DELIVERIES

Trucks enter from 228th Ave. NE on the west side of the job site.

CLEAN WATER

The team makes sure that only clean rain water leaves the site.

WORKER RULES

All workers must follow Cornerstone and Lake Washington School District's job site policies and safety rules.
