17 YEARS AND YOUNGER

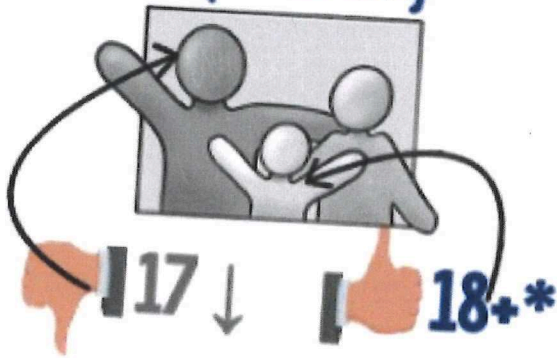
- You are considered a minor and in need of support when making decisions because of your age
- Your parents/family/caregivers make decisions about school and your education
- Your parents are automatically invited to your IEP meetings

18 YEARS AND OLDER*

- You are considered an adult and mature enough to make your own decisions because of your age
- Nothing about 'you' really changes, just your voice can make big, lasting decisions (which comes with responsibility)
- You make decisions about school and your education
- You can give formal permission for your parents/family to be in charge of making decisions about your education
