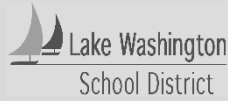

## School Mission

Emerson K-12 is a community of families working in collaboration with the Lake Washington School District to ensure that each student will be prepared to lead a rewarding, responsible life as a contributing member of our community and greater society.

## School Description

Emerson K-12 is a Parent Partnership Program (PPP) designed to engage families who are interested in being active partners in the instruction of their child(ren). As a public school, K through 12 graders can enroll at no cost. Core and enrichment/elective classes are generally offered two days per week, with parents delivering instruction on the other days in partnership with certificated staff. Each student has an individualized learning plan that meets LWSD and state standards.

Emerson K-12 is one of many Choice Schools in the LWSD that works to meet our District vision: Every Student Future Ready: Prepared for College, prepared for the Global Workplace, Prepared for Personal Success in a non-traditional setting. At Emerson K-12, our focus continues to be on helping support individual students in meeting District and state standards wherever their learning happens.

**District Per Pupil Expenditure:** \$22,144 per pupil

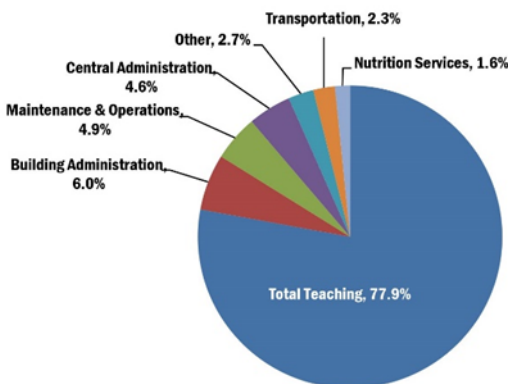
## 2024-25 School Goals
