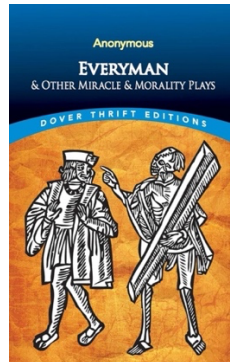
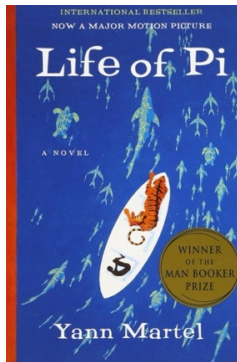




**Accelerated English II: 10th Grade

**Readings: *Life of Pi* by Yann Martel (ISBN-10: 9780156027328)
Everyman by Anonymous (ISBN-10: 9780486287263)**



Life of Pi is a Canadian novel by Yann Martel published in 2001. The protagonist is Piscine Molitor "Pi" Patel, a boy from Pondicherry, India. After a shipwreck, he is left stranded on a lifeboat in the Pacific Ocean with a Bengal tiger. This philosophical novel raises questions about the nature of reality and how it is perceived and told.

The Summoning of Everyman, usually referred to simply as *Everyman*, is a late 15th-century morality play by an anonymous English author, printed circa 1530. *Everyman* uses allegorical characters to examine the question of Christian salvation and what Man must do to attain it. Though the book you will purchase will come with other stories, you are only required to read *Everyman*.

On Thursday, August 20, you will have a test that covers both of the above works. You will not be allowed to use notes or the books themselves on the test.
