# School Fees 2026-2027

Fukuoka International School (FIS) is a non-profit institution that relies on annual tuition to support its operations. Due to rising operational costs in Japan and the competitive international school environment, modest annual tuition adjustments should be expected.

Voluntary financial contributions to support school programs and facilities are always appreciated.

## One-time Fees

The one-time fees below apply to new students and to those rejoining after withdrawal.

Re-acceptance Fee (for former students who rejoin only)	200,000

### Application Processing Fee

- Covers application costs; required for all applicants and re-enrollments.
- Non-refundable and payable at the time of application.

### Acceptance Fee

- Covers initial student setup.
- Non-refundable.

### Re-acceptance Fee

- Applicable to former students who re-enroll.

### Development Fee

- One-time fee for all new students.
- Supports long-term facility and school improvements.

## Annual Fees Per Student

These fees apply to all students every year. All annual fees are due on August 25 or at the time of enrollment.

Week Without Walls Trip Fee (Grade 6 to Grade 12)	50,000~120,000 (estimated)	Not charged to students enrolling after the trip.

### Facility Fee

- Supports maintenance and improvement of school facilities.

### Library Fee

- Supports upgrading and expanding library materials.

### Graduation Fee (Grade 12 only)

- Covers graduation materials and event costs.

### Accident Insurance Fee

- Covers student accident insurance.

### Yearbook Fee

- Not applicable to students enrolling after February 1.

### Extension Learning Fee & Secondary WWW Trip Fee

- Covers field trips and extended learning activities.

## Payment Options

Only Tuition Fees may be paid in installments. You may select one of the following:

### 1. One-time Payment

- Tuition and all annual fees are due by August 25.

### 2. Two-time Installments\*

- 1st installment (50%): Due August 25
- 2nd installment (50%): Due December 25

### 3. Nine Installments (Monthly)\*

- 1st Installment (20%): Due August 25
- 2nd - 9th installments (10%): Due on the 25th of each month from September to April.

*\*Families opting for payment by instalment must register for automatic bank withdrawal service. Additional handling charges and fees apply.*

## Re-Enrollment Fee

Current students re-enrolling will be invoiced a re-enrollment fee of JPY 200,000 per student to secure a seat for the 2026–2027 school year. Students with outstanding balances must clear all current-year fees before re-enrollment can be confirmed. The fee is refundable for withdrawals submitted by July 31, 2026.

The re-enrollment fee will be applied toward the 2026–2027 Facility Fee, and no additional Facility Fee will be charged for that student.

## Regarding Payments

### Payment Method

- We accept bank transfers only.
- Please pay by bank transfer under your child's passport name or student ID name, following the schedule on the invoice.
- Invoices are issued in May for current students and upon enrollment for new students.
- Please keep your invoice until all payments are completed.
- All bank charges are the payer's responsibility.

### Receipts

- A receipt will be emailed from [school.fee@fis.ed.jp](mailto:school.fee@fis.ed.jp) once payment is received.

### Late Enrollments & Early Withdrawals

- Parents are requested to submit a Withdrawal Form at least 15 days before the withdrawal date.
- All fees except tuition are charged in full.
- Tuition is prorated for late enrollments.
- For early withdrawals, tuition is charged through the last day of the month of the student's final school day.
- No refunds will be made for withdrawals in May or June.

### Delayed Payments

- The school is unable to release report cards, transcripts, references, diplomas, the Yearbook, or other records if payments are delayed.
- If payment is overdue by two months, the student may be suspended until payment is confirmed.
- Students with outstanding balances may not be allowed to re-enroll for the next school year until all fees are paid.
