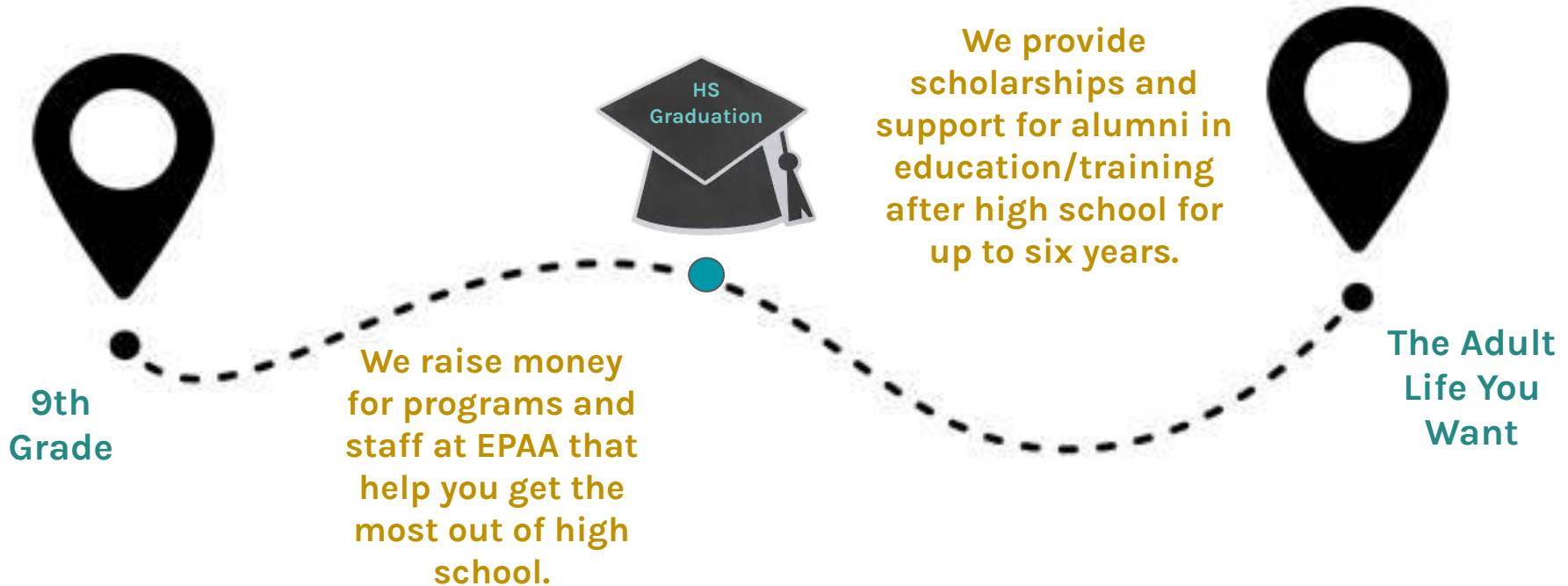

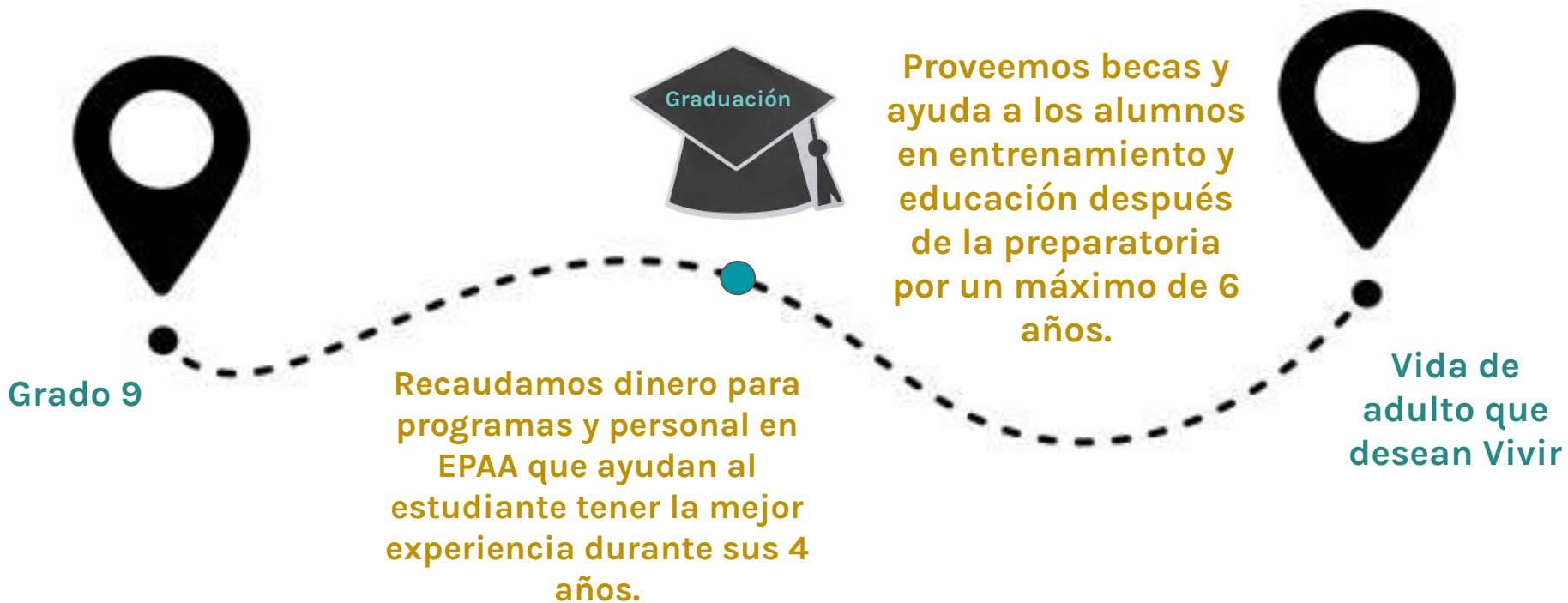

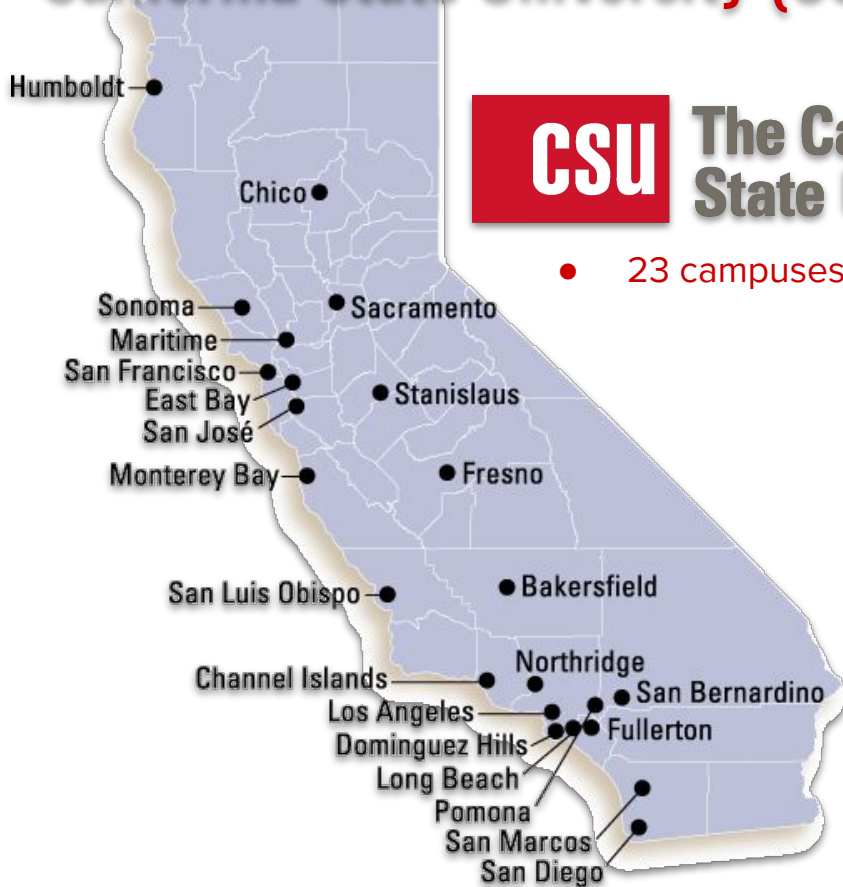

California State University (CSU) vs. University of California (UC)

CSU Requirements:

- ❑ Most CSU schools are less competitive than the UC system
- ❑ 2.5 or higher A-G GPA
 - 👉 If 2.0-2.49, they will consider other factors
- ❑ No SAT or ACT Required
- ❑ Deadlines for Applications: **12/02/2024**

UC Requirements:

- ❑ **Most UC schools are more competitive than the CSU system**
- ❑ **3.0 or higher A-G GPA**
- ❑ **No SAT or ACT Required**
- ❑ **Deadlines for all UC applications 12/02/2024**
- ❑ All research universities

Important Dates - Next Semester

January: Begin saving ~\$700 for 4-year college deposits (enrollment, housing, orientation, etc.) – need in May

January - February: Private College applications and CSS Profile Application Due

3/3: FAFSA/DREAM Application Due

April: Begin applying to community colleges, JobTrain, or Year Up

5/1: Intent to enroll + deposit for 4-year college due

ATTENDANCE MATTERS
Missing a day of school here and there may not seem like much, but absences add up!

WHEN A STUDENT MISSES 2 DAYS A MONTH.....	WHEN A STUDENT MISSES 4 DAYS A MONTH.....
They will miss 20 days a year.	They will miss 40 days a year.
They will miss 30 hours of math over the school year.	They will miss 60 hours of math over the school year.
They will miss 60 hours of Reading & writing over the school year.	They will miss 120 hours of reading & writing over the school year.
They will miss over 1 year of school by graduation.	They will miss over 2 years of school by graduation.

- **ATTENDANCE**
 - 95% attendance rate.
 - Unexcused/excused absences may affect grades.
 - Unexcused absences = truancy.
 - Truancy = not able to participate in school related activities until improvement.

- **TARDIES**
 - May affect class grades.
 - 30 minutes or more = absent in class
 - 5 tardies or more = not able to participate in school related activities until improvement.

2. returned all **outstanding fees and school materials** (e.g. books, technology, musical instruments, uniforms, sports equipment, etc.) in good condition **by Friday, May 30.**
3. completed at least **100 hours** of community service **by Friday, May 30.**
4. completed the **Senior Exit Survey**

Requirements to attend Graduation / Senior Activities

In order to participate in senior activities (including graduation), your student must:

1. have met **ALL the senior check-out requirements** mentioned on previous slide
2. have demonstrated **NO** behavior that warrants **suspension**, willful destruction/**vandalism** of school property , or have 3 referrals during their last semester
3. attend more than 90% of the days in the school year

You must also **sign the EPAA contract** stating that you understand these requirements and expectations.

Class of 2025 Graduation Contract

Graduation provides a time for ceremony, recognition, and celebration. **Attendance at this joyous event is a privilege that must be earned. Participation in the ceremony is not required for graduation from school.** It is our intent that each graduation candidate experiences the same courtesy, pride, recognition, attention, and respect. To ensure that this happens, we require that each student complies with the following graduation contract:

Graduation Requirements Checklist:

- 1. Student must have **met all EPAA graduation requirements** (a minimum of 220 units: 4 years of English, 2 years of math, 2 years of science, 4 years of history (Ethnic Studies, US History, World History, Gov/Econ), 1 year of foreign language, 1 year of visual and performing arts, 4 years of Advisory, and 4 years of Exhibition) per Board Policy (SUHSD 6146.1), EPAA Student Handbook, and Course Catalog. Must be completed by Senior Check-Out Day on **Tuesday, June 3rd**.
- 2. All **school materials** (i.e. textbooks, library books, technology, musical instruments, and sports equipment, etc.) must be returned in good condition AND all **outstanding fees** must be paid on or before **Friday, May 30th**.
- 3. Student must have completed **100 hours of community service** by **Friday, May 30th**.
- 4. Student must have completed the **Senior Exit Survey**.

Graduation Ceremony / Senior Activities Participation Requirements:

1. Any behavior that warrants **three or more referrals, a suspension**, or any willful destruction or vandalism of school property the last semester, may jeopardize students' participation in the graduation ceremony, prom and any senior-related activities. Please remember that 3 missed detentions for being tardy equals a referral.
