*****If you registered for Consumer Economics Online**, please check your District 86 school email and Canvas for communication from your instructor regarding how to access the course **near the end of the week prior to the start date of your course**. Students should use their D86 chromebooks to complete course material; no other course material or textbooks are necessary.***

- **For students enrolled in SIR- Year 1**, please remember you are to meet in-person at Hinsdale South on Monday, June 1 from 8:00 to 1:00 in the Library which is off the main circle drive entrance on Clarendon Hills Road.
- **Attendance Policy Reminders**
 - Students are allowed 2 full-day absences in a semester course. Any absences (excused or unexcused) extending beyond 2 days, students will be dropped with NO refund. Students must make up missed work during their 2 absences.
 - 1 Absence Full-Day (any absence greater than 2.5 hours); 1 half-day absence (between 10 minutes and 2.5 hours)
 - Three tardies (less than 10 minutes late) may count as a half-day absence.
 - Driver Education: Students are allowed 2 absences total; this includes any missed driving appointments as well as any missed class time.
- Students should use their D86 chromebooks; no other course material is necessary. *Incoming freshmen and students new to District 86 will receive their chromebooks on the first day of school.*
- Snacks will be available for purchase during breaks. Students may bring food and water.

- Students who qualify for tuition assistance may show their District 86 ID and receive lunch items.

Bus Transportation and Car Drop-off Information:

1. Route information with locations and times for pick-up and drop-off will be sent a few days prior to the beginning of the first session and a few days prior to the beginning of the second session for those who registered. This information will arrive through the District 86 email addresses of the student and the parent/guardian email addresses provided on the bus transportation form.
