

Option #2 - Adjust and Revise the Budget & Submit for Vote

The board can modify the proposed budget and put a revised, lower spending plan up for revote.

Recommended when the Board wants to pass its own budget, revised on its own terms.

Pros

You can trim items and revise revenue expectations to build a budget that has a higher potential of passing.

Ability to incorporate additional community feedback into the final presented budget

Cons

Requires the District and Board to swiftly make programmatic and staffing decisions, draft new legal notices, and hold a revote on the uniform statewide date.
