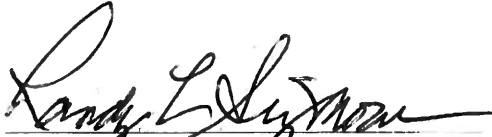

Vice President Speelman declared the motion carried.

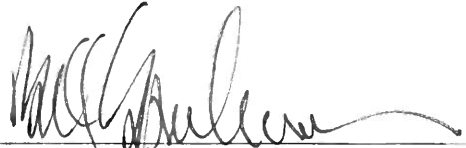
ADJOURNMENT
