Dear Wyoming Families,

As we head into the final week of school, we want to thank you for your partnership and trust throughout your student's time with us, especially as we prepare to celebrate the Class of 2026.

While we had many celebratory events this week, we also came together as a school on Thursday to focus on our school culture. Through a panel discussion featuring students and staff, our student body engaged in a meaningful conversation about belonging and how it connects to our core values. Everything leads up to Graduation Day on Saturday, May 30. The commencement ceremony will take place at 6:00 p.m. on the Graduation Walkway by the entrance to the Pendery Center for the Arts. Graduates need to arrive by 5:00 p.m. to meet in the Pendery Center Auditorium. The ceremony will begin promptly at 6:00 p.m.

It has been incredible to watch our community come together over the past several days. Having families, staff, and neighbors all showing their support gives the Class of 2026 a great send-off as they prepare for what comes next. Thank you for your continued dedication to our students and for being such an important part of their journey. We look forward to sharing the graduation ceremony with you next weekend.
