<p>Response:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Informal warning issued by Leadership via email Clarification of expectations and required actions Recorded in school system (Sentral) <p>Escalation:</p> <p>Continued behaviour = escalated to Level 2</p>	<p>Response:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Formal written warning from Leadership Communication restrictions implemented (if required): Single point of contact Email-only communication Meeting with Leadership if required (documented) <p>Escalation:</p> <p>Continued behaviour = escalated to Level 3</p>	<p>Response:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Immediate escalation to Principal Restricted access to school events, sites, or communication channels All communication managed through Leadership only Cancellation of Enrolment(s) 	<p>Response:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Immediate removal from site or interaction Police involvement where required Long-term or permanent restriction from school premises Cancellation of Enrolment(s) Legal action considered
