MCCRS for Mathematics: Exploring the Revisions

As part of our continued support for the implementation of the revised Maryland College and Career Ready Standards (MCCRS) for Mathematics, we are asking all educators to engage in a series of professional learning modules designed to build shared understanding and strengthen instructional practice.

The revised MCCRS outlines what students should know and be able to do in mathematics from PreK through Grade 8. The accompanying modules are designed to support educators in learning about these revisions and implementing them effectively through reflection, collaboration, and practice-based experiences.

Required Modules

- All elementary educators must complete the **Overview Module**. This module provides essential context, including the implementation timeline, the structure of the revised standards and Companion Guides, and an introduction to the Numeracy Development Framework.
- Elementary educators should also complete **one grade-level module** that aligns to their instructional assignment.

Stipend, PDPs, and Deadlines

- MSDE will provide PDPs to educators once the required state reflection is completed.
- CCPS will provide 3 hours of stipend pay for educators who complete the following by 9/1/26. Payment will be dependent on MSDE verification of course completion, which could take several months.
 - The Overview Module
 - One grade-level module
- Educators who do not complete the modules by September 1st will still be required to complete both asynchronous modules by the close of contractual day on September 18. Stipend pay will not be provided for courses completed after September 1.

These learning experiences are an important step in ensuring that we are collectively prepared to support students in meeting the expectations of the revised standards.
