- Establishes district vision and priorities
- Adopts policy
- Approves the budget for a public vote
- Hires and evaluates the Superintendent

WHAT THE BOARD DOES NOT DO

- Manage day-to-day operations
- Hire or supervise staff
- Address individual personnel matters
