

PUBLIC NOTICE

The Board of Education of the Black Horse Pike Regional School District hereby gives notice that a vacancy will exist on the Board of Education effective June 1, 2026, due to the resignation of a Gloucester Township representative.

The vacant seat is an unexpired term currently scheduled to expire at the Board of Education's 2028 Reorganization Meeting.

Pursuant to applicable New Jersey law, the Board of Education intends to appoint a qualified resident of Gloucester Township to serve until the Board of Education's 2027 Reorganization Meeting. The remainder of the unexpired term will be filled by the voters at the November 2026 General Election.

Any qualified Gloucester Township resident interested in being considered for appointment to the Board of Education should submit a letter of interest and resume no later than 4:00 p.m. on Friday, June 19, 2026.

The Board of Education intends to conduct interviews of qualified candidates during the regularly scheduled Board Meeting on Thursday, June 25, 2026, at 6:00 p.m. in the Library Media Center of Highland Regional High School.

To be eligible for appointment, a candidate must:

- Be a citizen of the United States;
- Be able to read and write;
- Have been a resident of Gloucester Township for at least one year immediately preceding the appointment;
- Be registered to vote in Gloucester Township; and
- Not be disqualified as a voter pursuant to N.J.S.A. 19:4-1.
