Please return the completed choice board to school by Friday, September 4th. The colored-in board will serve as your child's record of participation in the PreK Summer Assignments.

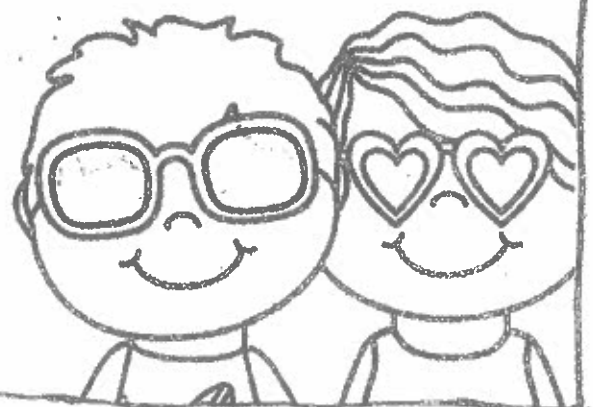
