## **STALLION SQUADRON Q & A?**

### **WHY SHOULD I JOIN A JROTC UNIT IN HIGH SCHOOL?**

With the rise of global communication, technology, robotics and mass information/knowledge availability, students competing in the job market after high school need additional skills to make them competitive. JROTC of any service offers team-building, communication, character-building, discipline, morale & project management skills. JROTC cadets receive DESIRABLE skills and training, and learn how to IMPROVE & LEAD themselves and others

### **WILL I HAVE TO JOIN THE AIR FORCE IF I AM IN JROTC?**

Students who join JROTC are in no way obligated to join the military including the Air Force after high school.

### **WHY SHOULD I JOIN DUNCAN's JROTC (Stallion Squadron)?**

Squadron is an accredited program that continually wins national, state, regional and local recognition for outstanding performance. Our program is one of the most active JROTCs in the Valley and over the years, our cadets bring home trophy after trophy in sports, academic, and drill events. Our Headquarters inspector said it best: "many JROTC units focus their success on one specific area such as fitness, competitions, academics, community service, or fundraising, but Duncan JROTC succeeds in all areas!"

### **WHAT CREDIT WILL I GET IF I JOIN THE CORPS?**

Students that join JROTC will earn P.E. credit towards high school graduation. However, if a student remains in JROTC for 3 years and chooses to go into the any military service they will enlist at a higher rank and immediately earn more pay after Basic Training. Also, college boards consider JROTC participation in high school as a positive reflection of commitment & self-improvement.

### **WILL I HAVE TO LOOK LIKE I AM IN THE MILITARY?**

Even though cadets are not enlistees in the military, they must meet Department of Defense and Department of the Air Force standards on hair, dress and appearance. Since cadets wear the EXACT SAME uniform as our real world Air Force, students in AFJROTC are held to a national/federal military dress and grooming appearance code that is more strict than school, district and state standards. So the answer to this question is YES!

### **HOW LONG DO I HAVE TO BE IN DUNCAN'S STALLION SQUADRON IF I JOIN?**

Students can choose to stay in JROTC for one or two years to earn P.E. credit. After your freshman year, you may decide to return as a sophomore cadet. Following your soph year, you may compete for Alpha Flight for elective or additional P.E. credit (junior and senior cadets); however, selection for Alpha Flight is limited by available seats.
