Presidential Education Awards

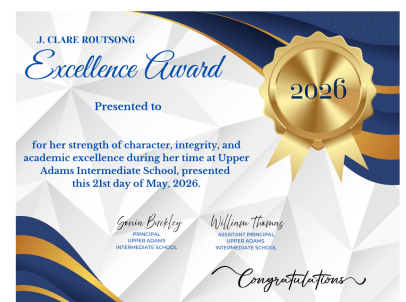


Upper Adams Jaycees Community and School Service Award

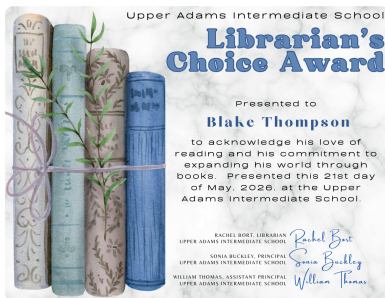
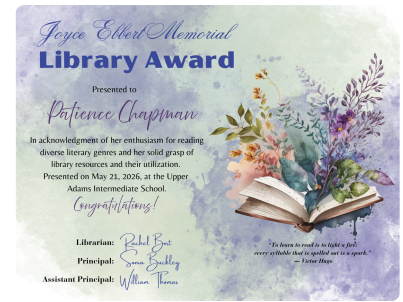
J. Clare Routsong Excellence Award

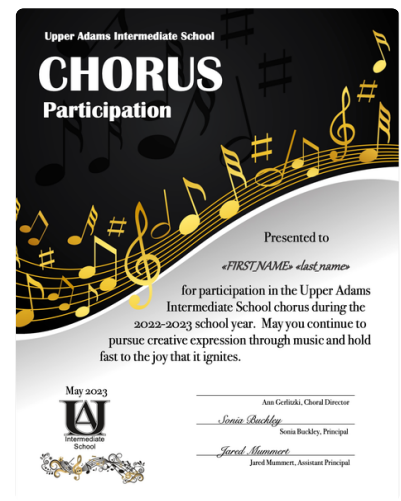

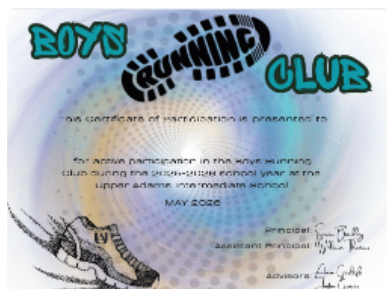

Math Olympiad is a world-wide contest which has been providing challenging and thought-provoking mathematical problems designed to strengthen students' mathematical skills. Participants in Math Olympiads are located in all fifty states, three US territories and in thirty foreign countries. In all, this year there were 4179 teams and approximately 70,000 participants. Students who earned awards rank among the best mathematicians on their grade level.
