## Dress Code Changes for 2026-2027

Every three years Marian Catholic assembles a Dress Code Review Committee comprised of faculty, staff, and students to discuss recommendations for any changes to our school dress code for students.

After review and thorough discussion with administrative bodies, the committee's recommendations were approved. **The following changes will go into effect on Monday, August 18, 2026 for all Marian Catholic students for the 2026-2027 School Year:**

### **Pants/Shorts/Skirts** **Dress Code**

Students must wear **Khaki slacks** (traditional classic cut or relaxed fit, chino style or Dockers style, cotton-twill), knee-length **Khaki** chino style shorts, or knee-length **Khaki** skirts.

**Not permitted: Pants of any color other than Khaki**, yoga pants, leggings, jeggings, sweatpants, cargo pants, track pants, denim jeans, jean-style slacks of any color, biker shorts, cargo shorts, denim or jean-style shorts of any color.

### **Jewelry** **Dress Code**

Students may wear earrings, finger rings, bracelets, and necklaces.  
Students may wear small/modest earrings in the ear or nose; other piercings are not allowed.

**Not permitted:** Extreme jewelry is not allowed. Jewelry with spikes, studs, or inappropriate images, gauges are not allowed.

**Note:** Tattoos must not be visible and must be completely covered during the school day.

**Dress code Khaki pants, shorts, and skirts may be purchased from any retail store.** Marian Catholic's Spartan Shop carries Marian Catholic dress code polo shirts and Marian-approved dress code outer wear and Marian Spirit Wear items, but does not carry dress code pants, shorts, or skirts.

## Athletics at IHSA State Competition

### Men's and Women's Track and Field at IHSA State Competition

Congratulations to our Men's and Women's Track & Field Teams who qualified for the IHSA State Championships!

**In Men's Track & Field:** Led by **Joseph Ingram, Jr.** and **Reginald Ibekwe** in two events each, Marian Catholic qualified six entries for this weekend's IHSA State Meet in Charleston through the Thornridge IHSA 2A Sectional last Wednesday. Shot Put sectional champ **Christopher Morgan** (12.96 meters) and Triple jumper **Ian Parker** made the grade as well. As a team, the Spartans scored 83 points to earn fourth place in the 11-school sectional.

**In Women's Track & Field:** Behind an effort of 11.31 meters, Marian Catholic **Arredia Primar** captured seventh place in the state last Saturday at the IHSA Class 2A state meet in Charleston. **Primar** also had top 20 efforts in the hurdles events, capturing 17th place in the 300-meter hurdles (47.63) and 20th place in the 100 hurdles (15.82). **Brooklyn Holmes** also led the way for Marian Catholic in Friday's prelims, capturing 15th place in the 100- and 200-meter dashes, and anchoring the Spartans' 400 relay team to 10th place in state. The relay, also including **Mikayla Frazer, Taija Scott and McKenzie Mixson**, timed 49.29.
