We help with general health concerns. These include:

- Check-ups and sports physicals
- Sexual health counseling
- Birth control, STI testing and treatment
- Mental health counseling
- Immunization, including COVID-19
- Nutrition, growth and development

What is the Wellness Center?

The Benson Wellness Center is a health clinic for students and community members. Doctors, nurses, and other health care providers from OHSU, school district health services and the county health department provide the care.

Who can get care?

All students, ages 0 to 21.

What do I do if I am a new to the wellness center?

Call OHSU registration at 503-494-8505. Once you are set up you can schedule a wellness appointment.

How much does it cost?

Services are free. We bill your insurance if you have it. You can still come to the clinic if you do not have health insurance.

Are services confidential?

Yes.

- Anyone 15 and older may receive medical services on their own consent
- Anyone 14 and older may start drug, alcohol, or mental health counseling on their own consent
- Anyone, of any age, may receive birth control and sexually transmitted infection services on their own consent.
