Dear Golden Rule Schools Families,

We are writing to inform you about an important change that will affect all Texas public schools, including charter schools, beginning this upcoming school year.

The Texas Legislature has passed House Bill 1481 (HB 1481), which now prohibits students from using personal communication devices—including cell phones—on school grounds during the school day. This law applies to all Texas public and charter schools and takes effect immediately.

At Golden Rule Charter Schools, we are committed to following all state laws and creating the best possible environment for learning. Although the law has just been passed and we are still working on the details of how to implement it on each of our campuses, we want to be transparent and give you advance notice that cell phone use will no longer be allowed during the school day, at any of our schools for the upcoming school year.

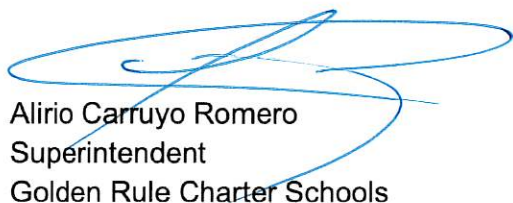
We understand you may have questions about how this policy will look in practice. At this time, those specific procedures are still being developed and will be shared with you before the first day of school. Please know that:

- This is a state mandate, not a Golden Rule Schools decision.
- We will be working over the summer to finalize the best plan for the new mandate enforcement. The plan will be communicated before the first day of school.
