Student Dress Code Expectations



Students are expected to dress in a manner that supports a safe, respectful, and distraction-free learning environment. The purpose of the dress code is to promote school safety, minimize disruptions, and maintain an academic atmosphere that reflects good character, respect for all, and positive school culture.

Shirts

- **Plain white, navy blue, royal blue, light blue, gray, black, or yellow/gold collared long-sleeved or short-sleeved polo shirts ONLY.** (*Logo should not be larger than a quarter.*) **Sleeveless shirts are NOT allowed.**
- Miller school spirit shirts, sweatshirts, and sweaters may be worn daily.
- Plain white undershirts or turtlenecks may be worn underneath approved tops.
- Clothing must not expose the waist, hips, or midriff and may not be low-cut, off the shoulder, expose the back, or see-through. **Crop tops are NOT permitted, regardless of whether an undershirt is worn.**

Pants, Shorts, Skirts, and Dresses

- **Plain khaki, black, navy, or blue jeans are permitted.**
- **Pants or skirts should have No rips, frays, holes, hanging straps, or cargo-style pockets. No sweatpants, joggers, leggings, biker shorts, athletic (basketball) shorts, cheer shorts, yoga pants, leather pants, camouflage pants, overalls, rompers, or jumpsuits are allowed.**
- **Shorts, skirts, dresses, and skorts must be no shorter than two inches above the knee at all levels. Tennis-style skirts are NOT permitted.**
- Pants must fit properly and may not sag below the hip bone. Belts are required if pants or shorts contain belt loops.

Jackets, Hoodies, and Outerwear

- **Only plain white, navy, royal blue, black, gray, or yellow jackets and hoodies are permitted. Hoods may NOT be worn inside the building. Hoodies should have no graphics, patterns, or stripes.**
- Plain blue jean jackets are permitted if they do not contain rips or embellishments.
- Oversized coats are not permitted indoors. *Oversized coats may be worn to school during winter months; however, they are not permitted to be worn inside the classroom.*

Shoes

- **All shoes must have closed toes and closed heels. No slippers, flip-flops, Crocs, slides, clogs, mule-style shoes, shoes with wheels, high heels, or stilettos are permitted.**
- **No platform shoes/boots or elevated heels exceeding 2 inches in height are permitted due to school safety and emergency evacuation concerns.**

Accessories and Personal Items

- **Only clear or mesh bookbags are permitted. All athletic bags must also be clear or mesh, including sports bags.** (*Exception: baseball and softball equipment bags.*)
- **Only clear water bottles with a secure lid/top are permitted. Metal or glass tumblers, cups, or containers (including Stanley-style cups) are NOT allowed.**
- **Lunch boxes/bags should be school-appropriate and no larger than approximately 10" x 8" x 5". Oversized lunch bags, coolers, or containers that cannot fit inside a student backpack are NOT permitted.**
- **NO hats, bonnets, scarves, wave caps, bandanas, skull caps, ski masks, or edge-control bands.**
- **NO pant chains, shoe chains, spiked bracelets, arm warmers, gloves, or oversized belt buckles.**
- **No fanny packs.**
- **Purses must be no larger than 6 x 9 inches (approximately the size of half a sheet of paper).** (*This includes male purses or bags*)
- Earrings larger than the size of a quarter, excessive necklaces, and excessive bracelets are NOT permitted
- **No extreme facial piercings, including oversized gauges, dermas, nose or ear bars, and septum jewelry larger than 5mm.**
- Non-prescription glasses or sunglasses may NOT be worn indoors.
- **Cellphones will be collected/secured in accordance with GA Law daily. No iPads, headphones, Meta glasses, smartwatches, audio recording devices, or similar personal electronic devices should be brought to school. All personal electronic devices, including cell phones, brought to school are at the student's own risk. According to Georgia state law, electronic devices may not be used in the building during the instructional day from 8:30 AM-4:05 PM.**

Hair Expectations

- Hair must be neat, clean, and well-groomed. Hairstyles or accessories that disrupt the learning environment may be prohibited at the discretion of school administration.

Disclaimer: Miller encourages students to express creativity and individuality through fashion while maintaining a safe, respectful, and school-appropriate appearance. Clothing, accessories, or personal items that display or promote alcohol, drugs, violence, gang activity, inappropriate language, offensive images, or other disruptive content are prohibited. Additionally, any attire or accessory that compromises safety, interferes with emergency procedures, or creates a substantial distraction to the learning environment, as determined by school administration, may not be permitted. Students participating in designated dress-down days are still expected to follow all school dress code expectations.
