### Attention Families of New High School Student-Athletes!

New Florida Law Requires ECG Screenings for New FHSAA Athletes Beginning This Year

#### Who Needs an ECG Screening?

- **Rising 2026 – 2027 Freshmen trying out for and/or participating in FHSAA interscholastic athletics in any/all sports**
- **New Student-Athletes in Grades 10 – 12, those who did NOT play FHSAA sports previously**

**Note:** Returning FHSAA student-athletes are NOT required to have an ECG, however, they can receive one if desired and ALL student-athletes must complete a sports physical documented on the FHSAA EL2 form. ECGs are NOT required for Band, ROTC, Dance, or Flagline.
