An opportunity has emerged for Millcreek Township School District to reimagine the leadership structure at the high school level in order to enhance the experience for students, staff, and families. The Pennsylvania Department of Education (PDE) has historically recognized McDowell High School and McDowell Intermediate as a single campus for 9-12 students. We believe that this leadership structure change will not only parallel PDE's recognition, but also facilitate more consistent policy implementation, clearer communication, and aligned expectations.

Leadership will be transitioned to a Principal, Associate Principal, and four Assistant Principals. We would like to congratulate Mr. Scott Quivey as he steps into the role of Principal of the soon-to-be unified McDowell campus. The Associate Principal position will be posted soon, and we hope to have it filled by July. This timeline will allow the new team to begin working through the unification process before students and staff return for the new school year.

Additional details regarding leadership roles will be communicated to the respective buildings. The McDowell Campus will undergo a rebranding process, gradually removing all signage indicating "intermediate" and redesignating the buildings as North and South McDowell. Beginning this summer, a unified website for McDowell will be launched, consolidating all information currently available on the existing websites.

We are confident that it will result in an improved overall experience for our staff, students, and their families. We appreciate your patience and cooperation as we implement these changes to become one unified McDowell.
