RISE is designed to assist young adults in transitioning from high school to adult life. We are here to help young adults to take their next steps, whether that is school, vocational training, or work.

RISE Provides Comprehensive Services Including...

- Evaluation of skills, interests, and abilities
- Referral for basic skills instruction, if needed
- Job Readiness Bootcamp, including:
 - Job seeking skills instruction
 - Soft skills training
 - Self-advocacy training
 - Workplace financial literacy
 - Traveling to work
 - And more!
- Paid job sampling in a community-based setting (Morris, Passaic, or Sussex county)
- Job coaching
- Job placement services
- Assistance in obtaining a GED, if interested
- Guidance in obtaining an apprenticeship or attending a trade school, if interested

Who is eligible?

- Age 16-24
- Resident of Morris, Passaic, or Sussex county
- Have a documented disability or are willing to self-certify limitations
- May or may not have a high school diploma
- Interested in exploring employment
- Interested in full-time employment
- Require support to prepare for, obtain, and maintain employment

When does the program start?

Admissions are accepted on a rolling basis, with different small cohorts starting throughout the year.

Where is the program held?

Job Readiness Bootcamps will be held at Employment Horizons (Cedar Knolls, Morris County)
Job sampling and placements will be within Morris, Passaic, and Sussex counties
