## 2026 Half-Day Sports Camps

### Summer Camp Begins with Athletics Half-Day Sports Camps!

#### **ALL SPORTS CAMP FOR GIRLS**

Let your daughter spend a week with Hollins University learning a wide variety of sports including basketball, volleyball, tennis, soccer, lacrosse, rock climbing, swimming and flag football. Each day campers will experience two different sports where they will be instructed on the basics of the sport from University coaches. This camp is perfect for allowing your daughter to experience a wide variety of sports from positive female role models.

#### **ARCHERY LEVEL 1 & LEVEL 2**

The camps core content includes archery history, safety, technique, equipment, mental concentration, and self-improvement. All instructors are certified by the Virginia Department of Game and Inland Fisheries (VDGIF) and have undergone a certification program referred to as BAL, 'Basic Archery Instructor.' This program will focus on the skills of archery, not hunting. Level 1 is a pre-requisite to Level 2.

#### **BASEBALL**

Campers will spend a week with a local high school varsity baseball team improving their hitting, fielding, pitching and base running with special attention paid to proper fundamentals.

#### **BASKETBALL**

Spend a week with a local basketball team honing the skills they will need to play organized basketball. Campers will be instructed on the basics of shooting, dribbling, and defending with special attention paid to proper fundamentals.

#### **CHEERLEADING**

Your daughter will spend a week with an area high school cheerleading team to offer a four-day cheerleading camp that will cover all aspects of cheering. Topics include jumps, tumbling, pom pom routines, yelling and safety with special attention paid to proper fundamentals.

#### **GOLF & LITTLE CHIPPERS GOLF**

Campers will be with 1st Tee of the Roanoke Valley learning the basic club grip, swing, putting, chipping, golf etiquette and life skills. Campers are required to bring their own age appropriate equipment to camp or request loaner equipment on your registration. Various golf camps available for ages 5-18 Coed/Girls.

#### **NEW: FOOTBALL FUNDAMENTALS**

Does your child love to play backyard football? If so we have the perfect camp that will allow them to spend a week with a High School Varsity football team improving their football skills. Each camper will be instructed on the basics of football with special attention paid to proper fundamentals. This camp is a non-contact camp.

#### **PICKLEBALL**

As the fastest growing sport in America for several years, pickleball has proven to be the most welcoming and inviting for any new players looking to try a new game! **Basketball** - Basics of offense and defense with proper fundamentals.  
**Volleyball** - Basics including passing, serving, setting, spiking, digging, blocking, and court positioning.  
**Swimming** - Dive into summer of our all-girls swim camp, where fun meets fundamentals and every swimmer builds skills, strength, and confidence!  
**Flag** - Join us this summer for our all girls flag football camp, where fundamentals, teamwork, and confidence come together in every play!

#### **SOCCER & LITTLE STRIKERS SOCCER**

Led by a collection of area college and high school coaches and players, these camps are sure to help your child expand on the skills needed for organized soccer. The format of the camps is based on the National Soccer Coaches Association of America's youth developmental guidelines that focus on the fundamentals of the game in a fun and safe atmosphere. Soccer camps available for ages 3-5 and 6-13.

#### **SOFTBALL**

Campers will spend a week with a local high school varsity softball team improving their hitting, fielding, pitching and base running with special attention paid to proper fundamentals.

#### **TENNIS & QUICK START TENNIS**
