Attention all parents, this is a reminder that this Tuesday, June 2nd will be our last teacher collaboration schedule of this school year and school will dismiss at 2:20pm. Parents, please make sure your students are up and ready for school and arrive at school on time every day.

Daily tardy sweeps during the school day will continue to keep students accountable in getting to class on time. We will also resume first period tardy sweeps now that the weather has been better too.

Parents, please continue to check your students' ATLAS portal to ensure all assignments are being turned in on time. If you need help setting up your ATLAS Portal please call your students' counsellor and they will help you with logging in, as well as setting up your EduText.

Spring Sports Awards and Athletic Signing Day – is tomorrow, Monday, June 1st! All athletes who are signing letters of intent will be recognized at our Signing Day starting at 5:00pm in the North Gym, and our Spring Sports Awards Ceremony will start at 6:00pm, also in the North Gym. Stay tuned for more information!

Senior Breakfast and Cap & Gown Distribution – is the Tuesday, June 2nd in the North Gym at 9:00am. Cap and Gown Distribution is immediately after the Senior Breakfast.

Senior Grad Nite – is the Wednesday, June 3rd and all seniors attending this trip must be at Bullard ready to be checked in and searched by 5:30am. Buses will promptly leave the Bullard North Gym Parking Lot at 6:15am.

Save the Date – Bullard Graduation – Get ready Seniors and Senior Parents! Bullard's graduation is On Tuesday, June 9th at 4:00pm at the Savemart Center. Tickets ***are not*** required. Savemart Center enforces a strict clear bag policy. Parking is \$10 and only a debit or credit card is accepted.

Some Important Reminders:

Attention all parents and students: Over the past several weeks, we have seen an increase in the number of students found in possession of vape pens and under the influence while on campus. Please be aware that having vape devices on school grounds is strictly prohibited and illegal for minors. These products often contain nicotine and other harmful substances that can negatively impact brain development, lead to addiction, and cause both short- and long-term physical and mental health issues. In addition to the health risks, vaping disrupts the learning environment and compromises student safety. We ask for your partnership in reinforcing these expectations and ensuring that all students make healthy and responsible choices.

Attention all parents and students!

This is a reminder that all parents and students are to abide by all traffic and parking laws. Any parent or student that is not following all traffic can be given a ticket by Fresno PD. Also, starting this week if any student or parent is parked illegally in a handicapped parking stall or in a non-parking stall, will receive a warning note on their window for the first offense. Second offense will earn that person a parking ticket by Fresno PD. All students drop off and pick up areas are on the street curbs of our campus. Students, teachers, and staff are only allowed to enter our parking lots during school hours.

Bullard has moved to using an electronic bathroom, hall, and nurses passes through 5Star Students. Every student is allowed 2 bathroom passes per day with a 7-minute time limit. Any student who exceeds the 7-minute time limit will be assigned lunch detention and added to the non-privilege list until they serve their lunch detention. Students who have a documented medical accommodation have been

added to the 5Star system to help meet the needs of our students.

Laptops: Attention students and parents! Since 2020, Bullard has been a one-to-one site, where every student should have a laptop. Laptops should be brought to school every day and students must get in the habit of using their laptops while in class or for their homework. With state testing right around the corner in April, we want all students to make sure that their laptops are in working condition. If you have any questions, please call our library and our librarian can help you!

Tardy: Sweeps: Attention students and parents. Tardy sweeps will be conducted daily, and during every period, including first period. Students who are caught up in the tardy sweep will be assigned a lunch detention and be placed on the non-privilege list until the detention is served.

Smartphone Policy:

Attention All Parents and Students –Students are to bring their Yondr Pouches to school EVERY DAY! The Phone policy is being enforced every day.

****IMPORTANT INFO., NEW STATE LAW**** - AB 3216 – PHONE-FREE SCHOOL ACT- was signed into law in November of 2024 by Governor Newsome. This law requires all schools in CA to have a policy that limits or prohibits smartphones, watches, or any other electronic communication devices at school during the instructional day. This is a reminder that all Bullard students must comply with our smartphone free policy. There is no opt-out. Every student has received a Yondr pouch and are required to put their phones in their pouch during instructional hours. Students will have access to their cell phones during the lunch hour only. Parents, please do not text or call your students during class time. Pouches must be brought to school every day and must be with the student at all times, regardless if they have a phone or not.

No Outside Food Deliveries: This is a reminder that no outside food from any food delivery service or parents will be accepted during the school day due to safety reasons. All food will be turned away and Bullard High School will not be responsible for any refunds.

Dress Code: We also want to remind our students that all students must follow the school dress code when at school and when at any school activities. Holes in jeans are allowed but may not expose the entire thigh, shirts that expose the midriff are not allowed, and no single item of clothing can be more than 50% red or royal blue. A copy of our dress code policy was included your first day packets. Students who do not follow our dress code will be asked to change or call parents for a change of clothing. Parents, please make sure to check your students' clothing when leaving the house.

Lastly, all student drop off and pick up areas are on the street curbs of our campus. Students, teachers, and staff are only allowed to enter our parking lots during school hours.
