



Summer School 2026 Information

Summer School Begins on Tuesday, June 23, 2026

Summer School classes are open to current students attending Upper Darby High School. All courses will be offered via the Upper Darby School District learning management system, Schoology. Summer School registration dates and deadlines are listed on the back of this form.

The fee for each summer school course is \$125. Students are limited to participating in two (2) courses at one time. *A third course may be taken with **written approval** from the student's grade-level Assistant Principal.*

All Summer School courses will be completed via Schoology. Students can either attend their scheduled session times in-person, or work remotely on Schoology and check in with their teacher either synchronously or asynchronously. Transportation is not provided for Summer School.

Students who successfully complete a Summer School course will earn credit for courses failed during the school year.

REGISTRATION INFORMATION:

Summer School Registration will take place between 8:00 a.m. and 2:30 p.m. on the following dates:

- June 8th for seniors only
- June 9th, 11th, 12th - All Grades (June 10 Graduation - no signups)
- June 15th - All Grades (until 12:00 pm)

Registration **WILL NOT** be accepted after Monday, June 15th at 12:00 p.m.

To register, contact your school counselor.
Official registration can only be completed by your counselor.

In order to be assigned to a course, payment must be paid in full with cash or money order (no checks) by June 15th at 12:00 p.m.

Priority for Summer School will be given in the following order:

1. Courses needed to graduate for seniors
2. Courses needed for promotion to the next grade level
3. Courses not needed for promotion in order from 11th to 9th grade.

Students will be assigned to a Summer School session that could be any of the following:
