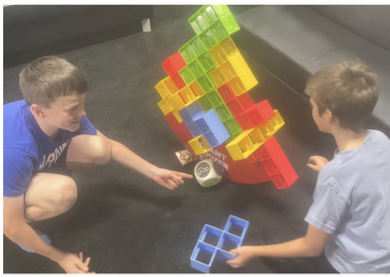

Fourth Grade Field Trip



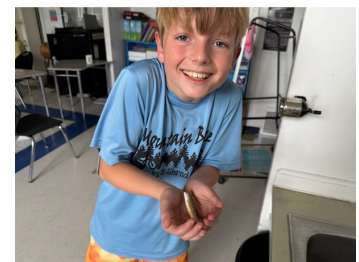
The Penobscot Marine Museum brings Maine's maritime culture to life on a 3 acre campus in the seacoast Village of Searsport. Exhibits throughout the campus tell unique stories of ship captains, and their families, the industries of Penobscot Bay, global Maritime trade, and today's fisheries. Each student was given a season pass to enjoy all summer.

Today our fifth graders were able to celebrate the end to being at Weatherbee by going to the movies and the Orono trampoline park.

Brook Trout



Students in fourth grade concluded their brook trout experiment on Wednesday. The students received approximately 2 dozen fry over February vacation. After learning about their life cycle, ecosystem, and observing their growth, the students bid their finned friends farewell and they were released into a private pond in Etna. Shy Beaver trout hatchery donated the fry for the purpose of education- the owner was not aware of brook trout that had been raised in aquariums to this age, as most are raised just past their hatch date. The trout thrived here in a 55 gallon tank with special refrigeration unit that Mr. Kiesman supplied. They are approximately 6 months old and most are 4 inches long at this point. We wish them well in their future endeavors.
