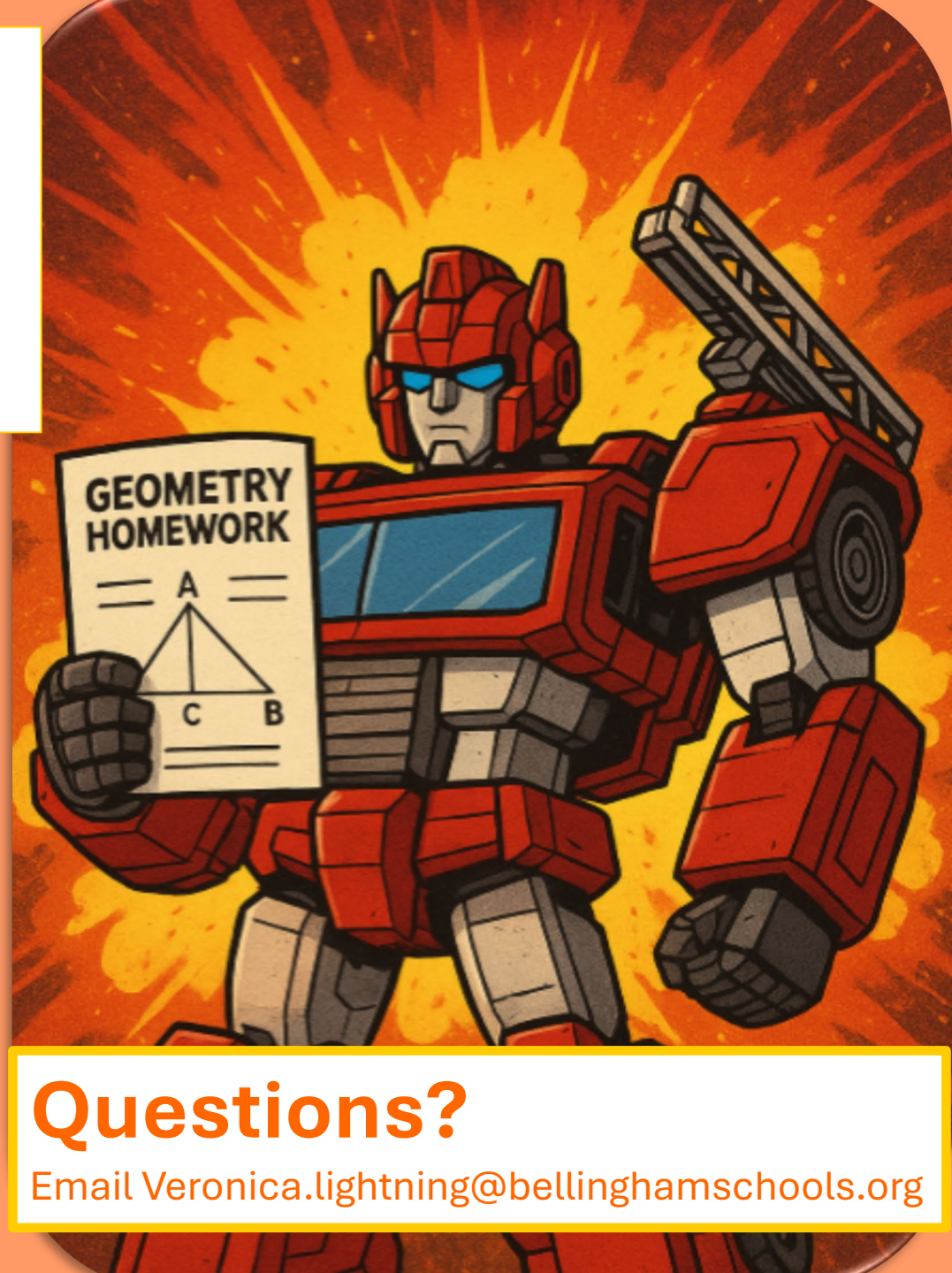

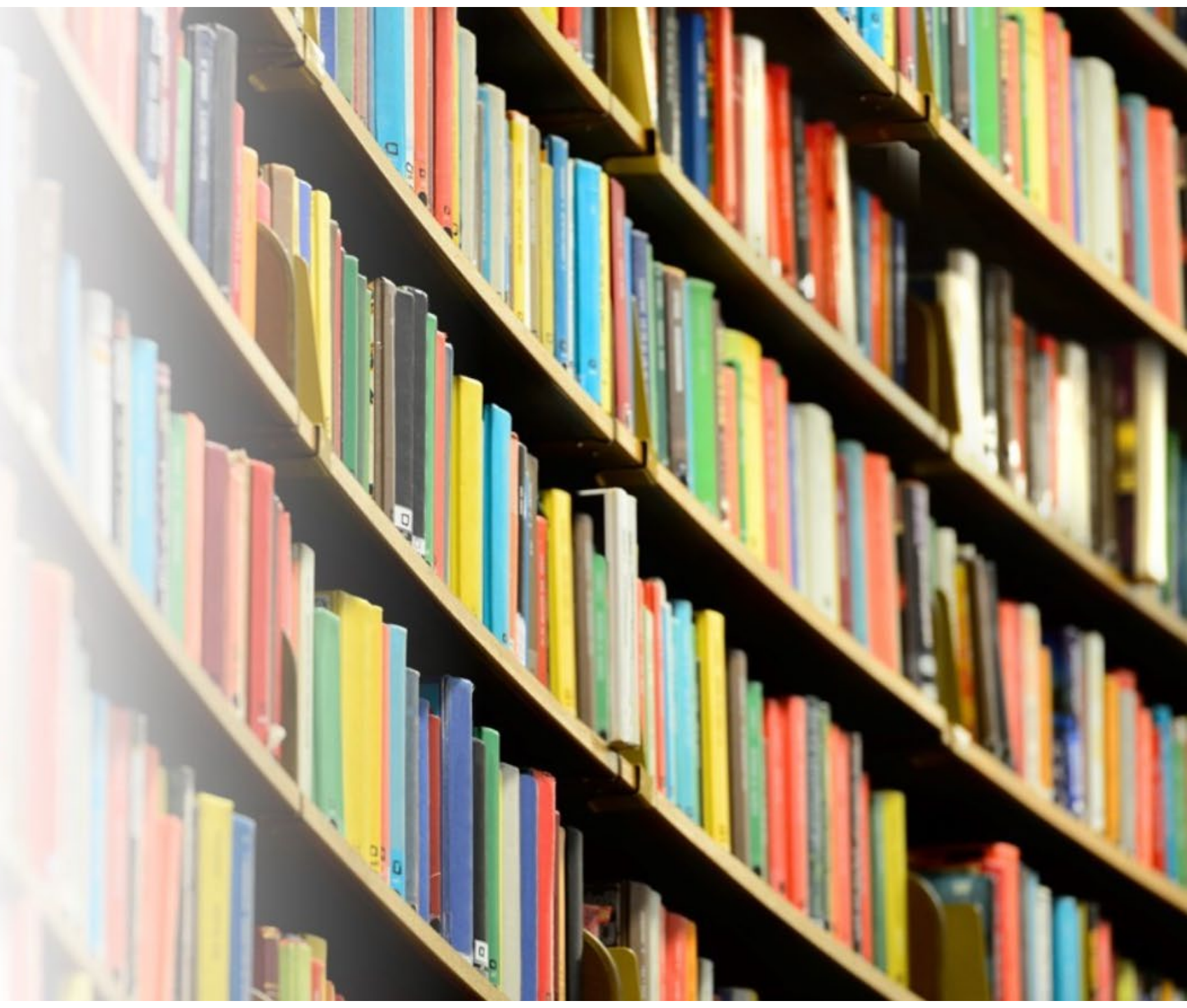
Hey Storm!

- **Monday, June 1: Day all books are due back to the library.**

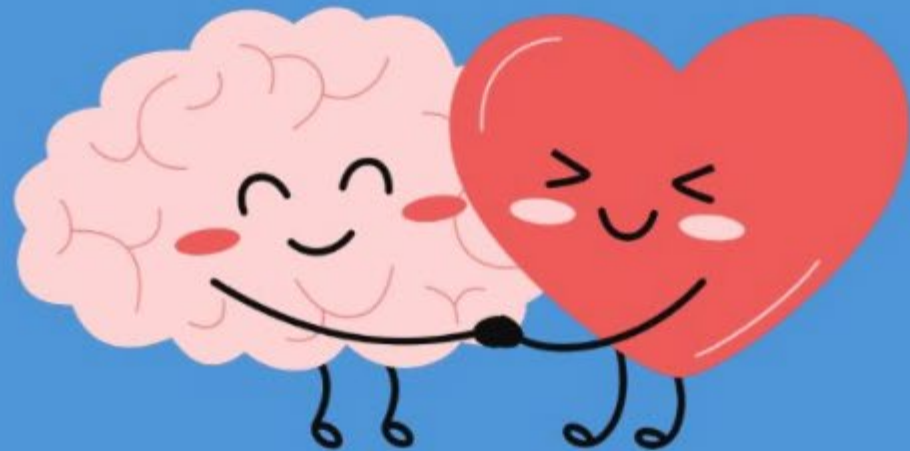

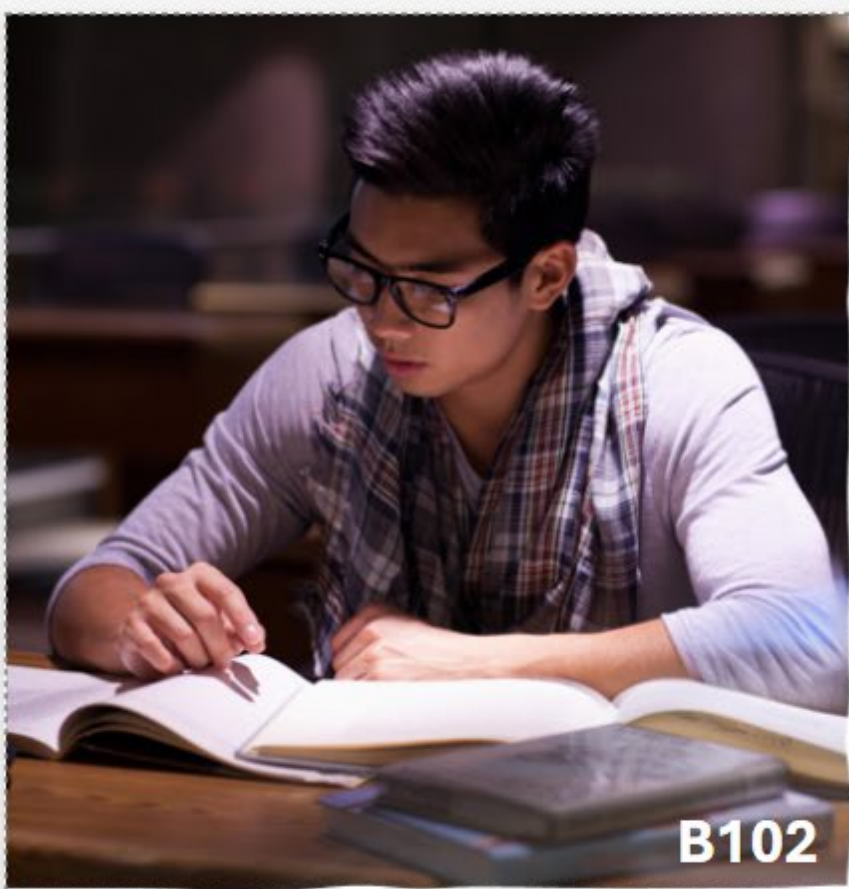
