As your principals, we believe there is no greater skill than learning to read and enjoy great books! Summertime is a great time to read and get lost in a story. We challenge our students entering grades 1-5 to read 20 minutes a day for **50** of the **79** days of June, July, and August (**June 12th-August 30th**). Simply color in the days on the calendar that you read for at least 20 minutes, have your parent sign your calendar and turn it in to your school during the month of September 2026. If you get busy and miss some days, you can read a lot in one day and count it on another day. For example, if you read 60 minutes in one day, you can count the extra minutes on days you missed.

What counts as summer reading? You read, you listen to someone read to you. Read a book, a comic book, a novel, a graphic novel, a picture book, or any kind of book!
