Qualified candidates will be driven and inspired by the mission of Catholic schools to form young men and women in a high school setting “who will be good citizens of the world, loving God and neighbor and enriching society with the leaven of the gospel, and who will also be good citizens of the world to come, thus fulfilling their destiny to become saints” (Miller 20).

Bishop Lynch High School seeks a mission-driven Wrestling assistant coach to support all aspects of the program while actively coordinating the development and promotion of the sport. The head and assistant coach will be responsible for providing leadership and oversight during practices, games, competition, and special events. The coaches are required to abide by the rules and regulations established by Texas Association of Private and Parochial Schools (TAPPS) and all governing organizations. Reporting to the head coach, the assistant coach must maintain a high level of ethical behavior and be an outstanding motivator.

- Plan and participate in summer camp(s)
- Organize and schedule practice sessions while developing educationally and age-appropriate game/performance strategies
- Communicate professionally and effectively with players, parents, vendors and head coach
- Attend all games, all practices, TAPPS competition and special performances as necessary
- Actively promote the formation of students and leadership development through the program
- Assume responsibility for inventory, selection and care of equipment/uniforms
