ADDENDUM 2

1. **Question:** How many nonpublic schools are expected to participate under this contract? Can the district provide a list of participating school names and approximate enrollment by school?
Answer: We are still in the consolidated application process. There may be approximately 126 schools which include in and out of network schools.
2. **Question:** Can the district provide a list of participating school names and approximate enrollment by school?
Answer: We will be able to provide this more accurately once the data collection process is completed.
3. **Question:** Can the district provide the estimated equitable service allocation amounts for Title I, II, III, and IV for the 2026–27 program year?
Answer: This is all in process at this time. We will be able to provide accurately by the end of July possibly before.
4. **Question:** Is the vendor expected to serve all participating nonpublic schools simultaneously from day one, or will onboarding be phased across schools?
Answer: Yes, the expectation is to service simultaneously from day one.
5. **Question:** Addendum 1 states that "most" participating nonpublic schools prohibit computer use by students or staff. Can the district identify which schools allow technology use and which do not?
Answer: We do not maintain a list such as this. You would have to communicate with each school and its administrator to determine which schools have this technology prohibition.

6. **Question:** Would virtual professional development conducted at off-site locations—not at the nonpublic school building—be permitted under this contract?

Answer: Yes

7. **Question:** The Cost Proposal section describes costs based on "an hourly rate specific to each staff title." Is the district's preference to evaluate cost proposals using this individual-rate format, or would a consolidated all-inclusive per-service-hour rate by Title program also be acceptable?

Answer: Information currently not available.

8. **Question:** The evaluation criterion for cost (25 points) references "lowest cost of implementing the proposed project." Is cost evaluated on total proposed annual cost, on per-unit rates, or both? Will the district apply rates to a standardized volume estimate to compare vendors on an equal basis?

Answer: Information currently not available.

9. **Question:** Page 6 of the RFP references submission via sealed physical envelope to 105 South Madison Avenue, Spring Valley, NY 10977. Page 15 references "electronic submission." Please confirm the required submission method, and if electronic, advise on the submission portal or email address.

Answer: Physical Submission Only.

10. **Question:** Will there be an oral presentation or best-and-final-offer round following the review of written proposals?

Answer: Information currently not available.

11. **Question:** Is any organization currently providing equitable services to ERCSD nonpublic schools under a prior or expiring contract?

Answer: Yes, there is an organization providing services.

12. **Question:** Are subcontractors or subconsultants permitted under this contract, and if so, what disclosure or approval is required at the proposal stage?

Answer: It would depend on what service a sub contractor would provide. It would have to be disclosed and outlined in the proposal and be approved as a part of the overall contract if you are selected. The liability for the subcontracted party would lie with your company and all of this would have to be accepted by the district and if accepted , outlined in the contract.
