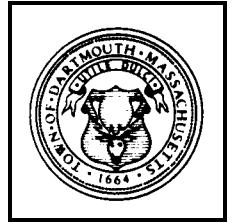

Position Title: Grounds Crew (seasonal)
Department: Facilities
Reports to: Facilities Manager

SUMMARY: The Grounds Crew performs a variety of landscaping tasks in support of the Dartmouth Public Schools Facilities Department.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

Primary responsibility is grounds crew landscaping maintenance for the Dartmouth Public Schools. This includes:

1. **Mowing**
2. **Weed whacking**
3. **Raking**
4. **Sweeping**
5. **Picking up litter**
6. **Daily responsibilities are listed but not limited to the above and include other related tasks assigned by the Facilities Manager or designee.**

QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS: To perform this job successfully, an individual must be able to perform each essential duty satisfactorily. The requirements listed are representative of the knowledge, skill and/or ability required. Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the essential functions.

EDUCATION AND/OR EXPERIENCE

1. **Knowledge and skill in landscaping and landscaping tools.**
2. **Experience operating motorized landscaping equipment such as lawn mowers, lawn tractors, weed whackers, blowers and other equipment used for groundskeeping.**

REASONING ABILITY

Ability to apply common sense understanding to carry out instructions furnished in written, oral and diagram form. Ability to deal with problems involving several concrete variables in standardized situations.

OTHER SKILLS AND ABILITIES:

Ability to develop effective working relationships with staff members. Ability to communicate clearly and concisely. Ability to perform duties with awareness of all district requirements. Strong attention to detail and accuracy. Organizational and time management skills.

PHYSICAL DEMANDS:
