Session I Credit Recovery Courses: English Language Arts and Reading – Grades 6, 7, and 8
Mathematics – Grades 6, 7, and 8

- Summer School Session I Credit Recovery is required for students who did not pass English Language Arts and/or Mathematics. This course is required to be promoted to the next grade level.

Session I College and Career Readiness

- This original credit course is designed only for incoming 8th graders. This is a credit in which the student must attend both AM and PM classes (7:45 – 2:45 PM) for Session I.

Session I HB 1416

- Students will have the opportunity to get targeted support in essential skills that will help them build a stronger foundation in English Language Arts & Reading and/or Mathematics. The extra support with these essential skills will help students be successful with their 2026 – 2027 courses. **By attending Summer School, students will receive 26 hours of the HB 1416 required accelerated instruction in each content area if they were not successful on the Math and/or Reading STAAR.**

Session II Credit Recovery Courses: Science – Grades 6, 7, and 8
Social Studies – Grades 6, 7, and 8

- Summer School Session II is only for students who are required/recommended to take Science and/or Social Studies to be promoted to the next grade level.
- Science and/or Social Studies are available for students who need to fulfill necessary requirements to be promoted to the next grade level. Summer School for Science and/or Social Studies is only **required** if a student's overall combined average (Mathematics, English Language Arts & Reading, Science, and Social Studies) is below 70, and their final grades for Mathematics and English Language Arts & Reading are both above 70, while their Science and/or Social Studies grades are below 70. Students will be notified by their home campus if Science and Social Studies Summer School is required/recommended to be promoted to the next grade level.

Session II College and Career Readiness:

- This original credit course is designed only for incoming 8th graders. This is a credit in which the student must attend both AM and PM classes (7:45 – 2:45 PM) for Session II.

Session II HB 1416

Attendance Requirements:

- Students are expected to be present and on time for class each day and after each break.
- Tardies will be recorded as absences. Students must make up any missed time to receive full credit. If the total missed class time exceeds 3 hours, the student *may* be dismissed from summer school without course credit, and all tuition forfeited.
