This week is a busy one for all our students. Below is a snapshot of this weeks events:

- **Tuesday, May 26**—For 12th Grade- Graduation Practices starting at 8:00 AM near the gym and for Grades 9, 10, and 11- Periods 1, 3, and 5 Finals, ending at 1:15 PM. Lunch is served from 1:15-1:45 PM.
- **Wednesday, May 27**—For Grades 9, 10, and 11- Modified Minimum Day, getting out of school at 11:00 AM (Lunch is served from 11:00-11:30 AM) and Graduation starting at 1:00 PM at the Toyota Arena in Ontario. Doors open at 12:00 PM and graduates should be in the loading dock by that time as well.
- **Thursday, May 28**—For 12th Grade- Diploma pick-up from 9:00 to 11:00 AM at the Theater and for Grades 9, 10, and 11- Periods 2, 4, and 6 Finals, ending at 1:15 PM. Lunch is served from 1:15-1:45 PM.

Summer School is scheduled to begin promptly at 8:30 AM on Tuesday, June 2, 2026. Students can access their assigned schedules will be posted on the cafeteria window on Thursday, May 28th, as well as will be available for students on Student/Parent Q beginning June 1st. If a student feels they should be in summer school and are not scheduled for summer school they may simply come to campus on June 2nd by 8:30 AM to meet with a counselor for assistance.

With Summer School, please be reminded that attendance impacts a students ability to participate in the program. Students are allowed up to two absences, and three tardies equal an absence. Please ensure your students are there daily and on time to each class period. Also note, there will be no school on Friday, June 19th, in honor of Juneteenth.
