CENTER STREET SPRING CONCERTS

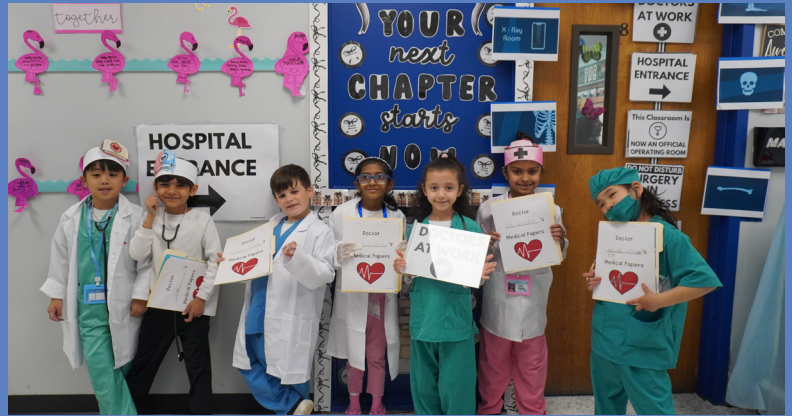

Herricks Middle School 6th grade Gemini students took a deep dive into Herricks history! Beginning with a timeline dating back to 1813 through today, students explored what makes Herricks unique, the events that shaped the community, and how its history continues to inspire growth and improvement. Their work included extensive research and alumni outreach, culminating in the creation of a book titled *Herricks Through the Years: A Learning Legacy*, using Book Creator.

The students then brought their learning to life with a field trip across the district. Following their timeline, they visited the original schoolhouse site, toured the community center and school buildings, explored other key historical and community sites, and even enjoyed lunch at McDonald's—formerly the home of Reverend Denton!
