## **Grade 3**

- One 2" Clear View Binder

- Earbuds/headphones (wired-not bluetooth)

- 2 Composition Notebooks (Wide-Ruled)

**These supplies should be labeled with your scholar's name for personal use:**

- 1 Package of Colored Pencils
- 1 Combination or key-entry lock (for locker - bookbags and phones will not be allowed in classrooms)
- pencil pouch or similar (if not using Chromebook case) to hold essential supplies (a few pencils, pens, erasers)

## **Grade 8**

### **Required:**

- 4 Highlighters (2 Pink and 2 Yellow)
- One Pack Notebook Paper (College-Ruled – label with name)
- One Pack Graphing Paper for Math (label with name)
- 5 or more white posterboards
- 1-subject Notebook/Composition book (History Notes–this will stay in the room, 1 subject is important)
- 1-subject Notebook/composition book for ELA work. You MAY use the one from Mr. Adams's class last year, or you may purchase new. I will retrieve these from Mr. Adams.
- 1-subject Notebook/Composition book or ½ inch binder (math notes)
- 1 sketchbook for Art (you can re-use from a past year, if it is still half blank or more)
- 1 box of gallon ziploc bags for Art
- Three Boxes of Tissues (community supply)
- FYI: you will need 1 flat (non-fitted) sheet in April for Shakespeare costume
- One planner, chosen by your family, that your child IS WILLING TO USE, and YOU WILL CHECK AT HOME.
