Twelve students from Discovery Middle School's Alternative Music class, designed for students receiving special education services, are set to take the stage and show off what they have learned this year as they perform a rock concert in the school's choir room on Wednesday.

Students will sing, move, play percussion instruments and boomwhackers, perform body percussion, and participate in improvisation activities and solo performances with a rock and roll theme. The set list includes "We Will Rock You" by Queen, a rock remix of "Rain, Rain Go Away," "Seven Nation Army" by the White Stripes, "Golden" by HUNTR/X, and a fitting finale performance of "School's Out" by Alice Cooper.

Alternative Music, designed for students receiving special education services, focuses on creating meaningful, accessible, and engaging musical experiences for all learners. In class, students work on musical skills such as steady beat, rhythm, singing, movement, instrument playing, improvisation, and performance skills, while also supporting communication, social skills, and participation.

This is not a public concert. Students' parents and guardians, select staff members, and special education students have been invited to attend. The guest list is limited due to student crowd and noise sensitivities and limited seating.

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
